## During Holidays

| Christmas and New Year holidays should be a time for fun and happiness. For many Texans, it will mean pain, anguish and possibly death. Major C.W. Bell, Regional Commander of the Texas Department of Public Safety, said, "The greatest killer of persons on the highways of Texas this holiday season will be the inattenitive, the impatient and the drunk driver." Major Bell said, "Alcohol is the biggets holiday killer during the Christmas-New Year holiday." Bell reminds the motoring public that "alcohol is not a stimulate," but rather a depressant. Even small amounts of alcohol tends to reduce judgment, self-control, and driving ability. Coffee will not off set the effects of alcohol, only time can eli- minate it from the blood stream. It takes at least one hour to oxidize one ounce of alcohol. The motorist does not have to be obviously intoxicated to be under the influence in order to become an unsafe driver. <br> Many accidents in Texas will be classified as one-car run off the road type. This means for some reason, be it highway hypnosis, driver inattentiveness, alcohol, drugs or mental-state, a driver loses control of his vehicle. Most of this could be avoided if the driver follows the most elementary rules of the road. |
