Vinyl Stickers

Texas Department of Criminal Cexas.
The license tag plant turned out
more than seven million more than seven million plates for
the Texas Department of Transportation at a cost of $\$ 1.21$ a plate, plus another 30,000 plates
for other customers for other customers for total sales
of $\$ 8.5$ million. The tag plant's companion stickers also set records with sales of $\$ 2.6$ million from more than 100 million stickers, ranging from windshield and license tag stickers
to registration and inspection decals for boats and gasoline pumps. inmates and it actually produces profit for the state," Texas Criminal Justice Board chairman, Alla olunsky said.
Gross profits were $\$ 2.3$
million at the tag plant and $\$ 1.6$ million at the sticker plant. More than 300 inmates work without pay in the license and sticker plant.
There are 140 different license There are 140 different licens,
