

#### A GOV'T ROAD EXPERT

Letter from U. S. Department of Agriculture Offering to Furnish Engineer to Supervise Road Building.

One of the most important announcements in connection with the road bond issue is made this week by Secretary Hardison of the Commercial Club to the effect that the U.S. Government will send an engineer to superintend the construction of the roads for which \$75,000 worth of bonds were recently voted.

The following letter from Acting Director Sargent of the Office of Puplic Roads, Department of Agriculture, is selfexplanatory.

Washington, Apr. 5. Mr. D. R. Hardison, Secretary, Commercial Club,

Brady, Texas,

Dear Sir:-

In reply to your letter of March 27, I am enclosing a blank form upon which application should be made for an engineer to superintend the construction of an object-lesson road. You will note that this application must be signed by the officials having legal control over the roads which it is intended to improve, they agreeing to furnish all labor. teams, materials and necessary machinery, while this Office will tend the construction.

If the application is signed and mediately, it is probable that we can send an engineer within a very short time. I suggest that you have the application signed order to make our arrangements.
