## WATER BONDS UP AGAIN

City Council Sends Judge Mewman to Ausfin to Interview Attorney-Genera Claims Issue Legal.

The City Council met in called session Wednesday afternoon to consider the water bond issue, and it was decided to send Judge Newman to Austin to again present the issue to the AttorneyGeneral's department and see if they could not get the issue approved.

It is the contention of Judge Newman that the issue is legal
and cannot be turned down for and cannot be turned down for
the reasons advanced by the Atthe reasons advanced by the At
torney-General's department vlz: that the tax rate is insufficient to cover the interest and sinking funds of both the water bonds and the street improvement bonds. The Judge contends that while a 25 c tax on the $\$ 100$ valuation was all that could be levied up to 1909. the legissia-
ture in that year divided the tax ture into two separate funds, one of 15 c on the $\$ 100$ valuation for street improvement, and one 25 c on the $\$ 100$ valuation for water and light and general purposes.
A tax of 20 c on the $\$ 100 \mathrm{val}$ uation is at present being levied to cover the interest and sinking fund of the street improvement bonds, which would leave a 20 c
tax that could be levied to cover the interest and sinking fund of the water bonds, and for all other purposes.

County Judge Harvey Walker is in receipt of the following county judge of Nolan county, in response to an inquiry regarding the power of the Commissioners court to assist the city in bilding bridges within the city ter covers the ground thorough y , and specifically repudiates the authority of a Commissioners court to construct or improve the streets and alleys of duly incorporated cities and towns. Of course this applies as well to the bridges within the curporate limits. Hon. John J. Ford County Judge Dear Sir: In reply to your favor of July 8th, 1910, we advised you that the Aet of the 31st Legislature conferring authority upon municipal corporations to assess the cost of street improvements upon abutting property owners had no application to the county and public property owned by the county. We advised you further that the county commissioner court would be without any funds of the county for the purpose of constructing and impror ing the streets of the city of Sweetwater.
At the request of Mr. J. W McDugald we have re-examine this question, but have conclude that the advice previously give you is correct.
The county commissioner' court is not given general authormerely such special powers as are specifically conferred by the Constitution and taws of thi state.
