The Brady National Bank has
just added a remarkable ma-
chine to its equipment-a ma-
chine that posts ledgers and
makes out customer's state-
ments. There won't be any
more night work balancing pass
books at the end of each month,
for the bank has done away
with the old pass book system
and adopted the statement sys--
tem, which the banks in the
largest cities are using.
People who are not acquaint-
ed with the inside workings of
a bank will not fully realize the
great advantages of machine
work over hand work in posting
to the ledger. The big advan-
tages of using the machine are
the saving in time and in the
improvement in the appearance
and legibility of the ledger
sheet.
Heretofore the clerks when
posting to the ledger have had
to first make a list of checks
