ELECTION HELD MONDAY ON RAISING TAX LIMIT TO $\$ 1.00$ AND VOTING $\$ 40,000$ BONDS-BOTH PROPOS
TIONS CARRIED BY NEARLY SIX TO ONE VOTE.

The tax payers of the Brady Independent School district last Monday voted to raise the school tax limit in the district from 50 c per $\$ 100$ valuation to the constitutional limit of $\$ 1.00$ on the
$\$ 100$ valuation. Incidentally they also voted in favor of a proposition of issuing $\$ 40,000$ for the purpose of building a new high 3chool building. Both propositions were put over by one of the
