Webb checked the moisture penetration and found on land with sparse or no cover the moisture penetrated about 5 inches; whereas on same type of soil about 6 feet away under a good cover of buffalo grass the moisture penetrated about 10 inches. In an area of low rainfall it is necessary that we get as much water in the ground as possible; and the best way to obtain maximum use of our rainfall, is by getting a good cover of grass on our rangeland, Webb points out. |
