Said Court will receive proposals from any banking corporation, association or individual banker in said County that may desire to be selected as the Depository of said County.

Any Banking Corporation, association or individual Banker in said County desiring to bid shall deliver to the County Judge on or before the First day of the Commissioners' Court at which the selection of the Depository is to be made a sealed proposal, stating the rate of interest that said banking corporation, association or individual banker offer to pay on the funds of the County for the Term between the dates of such bids and the next regular term for the selection of a depository.

**FIVE LAND OWNERS' PLANS APPROVED**

The Board of Supervisors of the Coke County Soil Conservation District approved five land owners applications for planning and application assistance at their regular monthly meeting, January 9, 1951, according to W. C. Shamblin, Secretary of the Board.

The personnel of the Soil Conservation Service were directed, by the Board of Supervisors, to gather necessary range, soils, and water data on Marvin Simpson, Fred Roe, Mennelle Brothers, C. M. Byrd, and B. A. Boykin's farms and ranches to render these land owners assistance with the development of a complete coordinated soil and water conservation plan on their farms and ranches, Shamblin explained.

Frank Keeney, who owns land four miles northwest of Bronte and is a member of the Northwest Bronte Conservation Group, developed a complete coordinated soil and water conservation plan last week. The plan was developed by Keeney with the assistance of the Soil Conservation Service assisting the Coke County Soil Conservation District. The plan included such practices as seeding of range grasses, range improvement, constructing level broad base terraces with ends closed, seeding and farming on the contour, and protecting crop stubble on or near the surface of the soil.

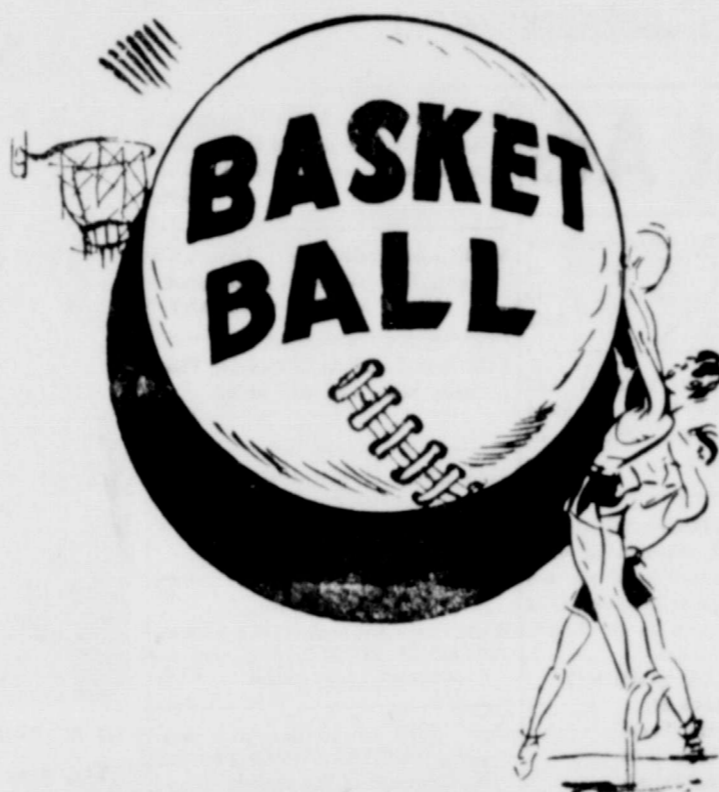
