## Santa Coming Here Saturday

### Teams Take Consolation

Both the boys and girls basketball teams of Bronte High School took consolation honors last weekend at the annual Robert Lee invitational tournament. The boys downed Roscoe in the final game and the girls outscored Miles to win their trophy.

#### Boys Games

In their opening game Thursday the boys lost to Sands 41-36. Scoring for the Longhorns were Alan Barbee with 14; Nelson Coulter 12; Jim Dan Raughton 6; Marvin Waldrop and Kit Carlton 2 each.

The Thursday defeat put the locals into the consolation bracket and they met Sterling City Friday, taking a 49-34 win. Raughton was high pointer with 15; Barbee had 14; Coulter 8; Waldrop and Carlton 6 each.

The Longhorns took an easy 44-27 win over Roscoe Saturday in the consolation finals. Barbee was high with 13; Raughton was on his heels with 12; Waldrop 7; Carlton and Coulter each had 6.

Raughton was the only Bronte player selected for the all-tournament team.

### School Board Meetings Open

School board meetings are open to the public, Supt. C. B. Barbee said this week. According to the laws of the State of Texas, all board meetings must be open to the public, with one exception: when the board is discussing employment of and setting salaries of personnel, it is allowed to meet without observers being present. However, salaries of personnel are a matter of public information and may be secured by any interested citizen.

Minutes of board meetings also are open to be public. Only stipulations are that the minutes read, or may not take the minute book from the office and he must sign the register.

The only way a person can get an item brought before the school board is to receive approval of the superintendent or president of the board no later than the Friday before a forthcoming board meeting.

Complaints must be filed in writing at least 30 days before a meeting date with the superintendent or president of the board and must specify the nature of the complaint.

Visitors to board meetings can participate in the discussion only on invitation of the presiding officer. If the board room becomes too small to accommodate visitors a larger facility will be provided.

Supt. Barbee said attendance at board meetings enables a school patron to get first hand and correct information on board actions. He encouraged Bronte School patrons to attend any board meeting in which they are interested.

#### Girls Games

The girls also lost to Sands in their Thursday opener at Robert Lee. Score was 55-50 in an overtime contest. Sue Ann Lee hit a big 20 points; Sherrie Coulson was close behind with 18; Debra Hibbs had 12.

Their Friday game gave the local lassies a 51-25 win over Sterling City. Lee was high again with 23 and Coulson sank 18.

Saturday afternoon's consolation finals was a good game and the Bronte girls took it 48-41. Coulson was high with a huge 32 and Lee had 10.

Guards Jean Ann Raughton and Norma Thompson received all-tournament team honors.

#### Teams Down Eola

Both boys and girls teams took wins when they went to Eola Tuesday night.

The girls downed their hosts 49-39. Scoring for Bronte were Coulson with a big 31; Lee had 12; Hibbs had 6.

Eola season record is 18-2 and both losses were to Bronte. Coach said Bronte guards did an excellent job.

The Longhorns downed Eola 56-42. High pointer was Raughton with 21; Coulter had 18; Barbee 8; Waldrop 4; Carlton 3; Andy Eubanks 2.

Everybody will be playing at Robert Lee Friday night. Boys and girls A and B teams will hit the hardwood and the action will start at 4 p.m.

### Mrs. Roe Named In Who's Who

Mrs. Fay Roe, Coke County Extension Agent, has been selected for listing in the first edition of The World's Who's Who of Women. The book was published in England. It took two years to produce the book with 6,800 biographies more than 500 of which are illustrated with portrait photographs.

In the foreword of the book the editor states that women from all walks of life are included. There is no advertising nor payment attached to being included in the book.

Honors of this kind are nothing new to Mrs. Roe. She was listed in the sixth and eighth editions of Who's Who of American Women and in Personalities of the South in recognition of past achievements and outstanding service to community and state.

Mrs. Roe was born in Lamar County, the daughter of Mrs. Hester Crosslin of Robert Lee and the late C. B. Crosslin.

Mrs. Roe was Coke County's first Home Demonstration Agent. She has served Coke County 18½ years as County Extension Agent since her first year in 1944. She was married to A. J. Roe Jr. of Robert Lee Feb. 3, 1946. She is

- \* Considered three recommendations from the school's Student Council: 1. length of hair—did not rewrite policy to provide for long-

- er hair length but agreed policy could be more flexible; 2. concession machines—permitted concession machines to be operated if the facility is satisfactory and fills a need; 3. designating smoking areas—the board refused to designate areas in which students will be permitted to smoke.

- \* Reviewed football financial report.

- \* Reviewed bus drivers' penalty system.

- \* Named Merle Griffin a bus driver, as he has complied with all requirements.

- \* Authorized any two members of the board to sign payroll checks.

- \* Appointed Mary Frances Green census enumerator, provided a 1974 census has to be made.

- \* Reviewed financial condition

of the school's operating fund.

- \* Noted that Supt. C. B. Barbee would be in an advisory meeting Jan. 9, 10 and 11 and encouraged all board members to attend.

- \* Reset date of January board meeting from Jan. 10 to Jan. 7.

- \* Agreed to appoint members of the board of equalization at their January meeting.

- \* Approved Bronte School to participate in Community Education Pilot Program in cooperation with the Education Service Center, providing most of the financing will be done with other than local funds.

- \* Updated Title I information.

- \* Discussed a new contract with Lone Star Gas effective Jan. 25.

- \* Drew up guidelines pertaining to energy crisis. Students will be handed information before school is dismissed Friday.

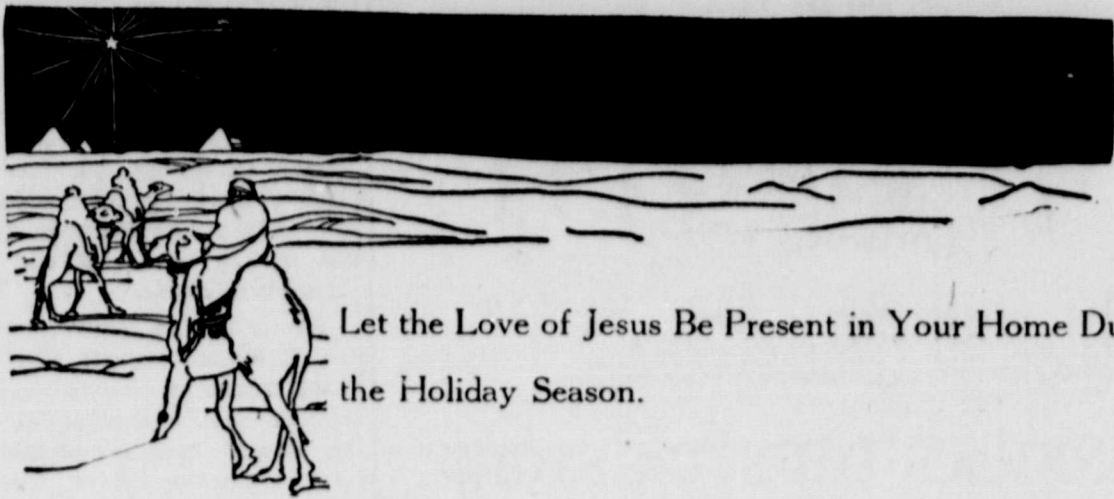

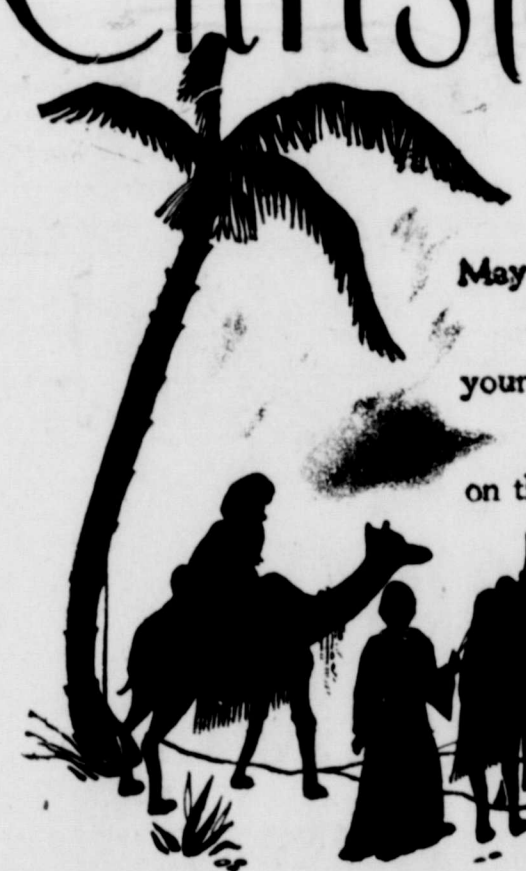

## Winter Barges in With Cool Temps

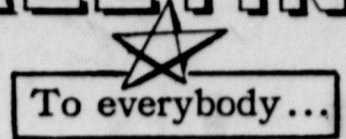
Old Man Winter decided to end the summer like weather in which residents of this area had been basking for several days, and sent a cold blast of frigid air through here Tuesday night.
