JOINT RESOLUTION. Amending Article 6, Section 2, of the Constitution of . the State of Texas requiring] all persons subject to a poll + tax to have paid a poll tax and to hold a receipt for same before they offer to vote at any election in this State, and fixing the time of payment of said tax.

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Texas.
