 Brigadier General Daniel W. Berham, United States Army, re-ired, who died ot Tiffin, O., on September 16, began his militar career as a private in the Sixth Ohio infantry in April, 186r. He
served in that regiment until the sefved in that regiment until the
following August. In October he aecepted an appointment in the regular army as second lieutenant in the Eighteenth infantry. He was promoted to first lieutename in 1863 and to captain in 1865 . He was ry in December, 1868, and lieuten ury in December, 1808, and heuton-
ant colonel and colonel of the same regiment in July, 1892 , and July, : 997 , respectively. His retirement as colonel in July, 1808, was due to
disability in line of duty. He wa disability in line of duty. He wa apointed a brigadier general on the
retired list on April 23. 1904. Genral Benham was brevetted captain on December 31, 1862, and inajo on March 13. 1865. for gallantry
