

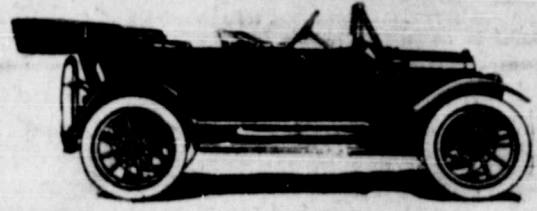

THAT DAM PROPOSITION

Meeting Held Saturday Night—C. M. Stanley Will Dam Colorado at Mouth of Grubbs Canyon and Irrigate 200,000 Acres.

Hon. Chas. M. Stanley the irrigation promoter was here Saturday night and spoke to a large crowd of citizens in an open air meeting on the street. Another meeting will be held at the court house, Saturday afternoon.

Mr. Stanley explained the proposed dam across the Colorado river which will impound enough of the flood water to irrigate 200,000 acres in the Colorado Valley in Coke and Runnels and from which water will be taken to irrigate additional land in Tom Green County near Miles.

Mr. Stanley stated that the dam would be built across the river at Grubbs canyon a natural dam site 23 miles above Robert Lee. This will enable him to irrigate the fertile valley lands on each side of the river from the dam site to Robert Lee and below Robert Lee. He stated that the proposed change in the former plans of placing the dam where it will be built instead of below Robert Lee is because the site above this place is some 300 feet higher, will give better force and

that will not submerge valuable farm lands below town that would have been submerged by building it at the first proposed site.

Mr. Stanley is now completing the survey in this vicinity and the meeting Saturday will be for the purpose of raising money to finish up the work. Bronte and Miles have contributed to this immense project by subscribing to the stock and it is now up to Robert Lee and this part of Coke county to contribute her share. When built the system will be of more advantage to Robert Lee and this part of the country than any other. Section. Mr. Stanley wishes to secure \$5000 at the meeting Saturday with which to finish up all preliminary work. Come out Saturday afternoon and come prepared to help out. Everyone can help some, and a little help from everyone is all that is needed. The amount you subscribe will not be in the way of a bonus but stock will be issued to you to cover every dollar you give. Come out and help boost a proposition that will make the Colorado Valley the garden spot of Texas.
