

Emstitution of "lightless withts" would snuff out entirely the "white ways" of cities which now are permitted to bern all lights for a period of two and a quarter hours a night. Dewould darken for the nights be named all window dissigns of shops, hotels and M. Simpson's.

Nation Wide Prohibition Wins

Washington, Dec. 17.-Na tion wide brohibition won in the House to day and only the adjustment of a slight difference in resolutions between the House and Senate now stands in the way of submitting to State Legislatures an amendment to the Federal Constitution forbidding the manufac ture, sale or importation of in toxicating liquor for beverage purposes in the United States of its territories.

The vote in the House, taken after a day of debate before crowded galleries, was 282 to 128, with the parties dividing almost evenly. The margin for prohibition was just eight votes more than the necessary twothirds of the membership of the House required for adoption and twenty six more than two thirds of those voting.
