

- 2 teaspoons salt 3/3 cup vinegar
- 3 tablespoons onion juice
- 2 cups salad oil but never

3 tablespoons poppy-seeds

Mix sugar, mustard, salt and vinegar. Add onion juice and stir it in thoroughly. Add oil slowly, beating constantly, and continue to beat until thick. Add poppyseeds and beat for a few minutes. Store in a cool place or the refrigerator, but not near the freezing coil.
