


San Angelo and Robert Lee golfers dominated the action in the Annual Mountain Creek Junior Partnership held here July 16.





The bridegroom is a 1974 graduate of Robert Lee High School and is a sophomore at the University of Texas at Austin. He is employed for the summer with an oil company.


