The Portales Power and Irrigation Company desire to call the attention of the farmers to the fact that it is now time to conclude contracts for next year's operation. There will be a number of farmers who will want to put in motors on their farms and unless arrangements are made early, it will be difficult to get motors in. The manufacturers in theeast are now promising only three and four months delivery on Electric motors. If you want a motor next March you must order it in December.

Remaining last year's power accounts must be settled up during the month of December, without fail as our books must be closed the first of January. Any unsettled accounts on January 1st will be placed in the hands of the Bank for collection and increased interest rate will be in immediate effect.

A small unit will be installed in the Power Plant to take care of winter Ue We expect this Unit to be ready for operation by January 20th.
