Town of the Future and a Country of Vast Possibilities.

At least some prince of pen- says "enough" let us come to a practical discussion of new country, Bailey county, Virginia City, Texas, and a day's visit spent of its promise to the seeker. The question with prospectors has been, not whether the soil is capable of large production, but whether it does produce from year. Knowing that much of the country through which we passed was of very the same character as that of Virginia City district, I went to see what the farmers the way were doing and they seemed to plan for permanent and successful homes for so-called arid lands. Far than I expected, I found a process of home-building going on. The proverbial shack given place to substantial homes, and groves and yards are growing up just as we have seen them "at home." Our faith in the country was strengthened by the trip across. Virginia City is in the midst of a body of land stretching every direction from the town, as the sweep of the sea and an inexhaustible capacity of production. None of the soil has excess of sand, much of it being of red color and sufficiently to resist the blowing winds. My candid belief that no soil can be found on the plains than that offered for sale at Virginia City by the Vaughan Land Co. Whatever grows on the plains will grow here, wheat, corn, milo maize, alfalfa, broom corn, potatoes, beans, melons, cucumbers, pumpkins and all other things that grow in such abundance else-

where in this great western country. It might be well at this point to call attention to a thing which many are not familiar with, namely, that a breakfast food is now being manufactured from Kaffir corn, and it is said to be an assured success. This means an enlarged market for this grain and is a hopeful prophecy of a still larger service it is to render in feeding the hungry millions when its real place is assigned it. As much can be said of milo maize which is of practically the same chemical composition. The intrinsic value of these lands as measured by their productive capacity is enough to guarantee the future of the country, but the Virginia City country has the advantage of being nearly in the center of Bailey county with the practical certainty that it will become the county seat as soon as the population of the county will justify the establishment of a capital. A further fact not overlooked these days in the development of a new country is that the making of the Virginia City country is in the hands of a progressive and trustworthy promotion company, the Vaughan Land Company of which Mr. M. Before our return we went down to Monument Lake near the townsite and climbed along the rugged cliff on its east side until we reached the cave where "Billy the Kid" is said to have had his haunt in the days of his desperation. The cave is at the foot of the cliff and is sufficiently large for hiding oneself and has a small opening low down well adapted for the hiding of a criminal who planned the destruction of any would-be encroacher. Below the cliff at one side is a beautiful artificial lake of clear water believed to be supplied from the earth as it is full from year to year. In the midst of landscape indescribably beautiful and the center of a large territory of rich

soil, Virginia City is destined to be the home of a prosperous and happy people.

Second Snow in March.

The second snow for the month of March this year fell Tuesday night and Wednesday morning. The atmospheric condition had been quite favorable except for strong winds and nobody seemed to be looking for such a good thing. The amount of the fall is estimated at three to six inches but it is impossible to know just what it was since much of it melted before the snowing had discontinued. Two snows in March are sufficient to put on a good staying smile—and they will make a good growth of grass as well. Farm work will be advanced greatly and with some showers in April we will have a record making crop this season.

The recent snow is nothing to be mad about. Straighten up your face and smile.

A country is not built in a day. Some of us have been impatient because we didn't wake up the next day after we got here to find everything as fully developed as we left it at home.

The canning and pickling factory will afford an opportunity to turn some of your labor into money, and after all isn't that about what you have been rubbing your head over? Come out to the court house tomorrow and let us talk it over.

Many good people came to this country without making up their minds to stay. Most of them won't stay—it's so different from "back at home." We wish they would, but the country will grow right on, for people are coming to stay and they are doing well.

One citizen, who knows this country best from a long period of residence here, has prepared the soil for planting fifty acres of Mexican beans. A number of men in the same community will plant several acres, some of them as many as twenty five. We will promise to give the result of this planting to Mr. Robinson of the Register Tribune as soon as the facts are in.

Farmers' Organization Needed

There is undoubtedly an urgent need for an organization of farmers for the promotion of the interests of agriculture in every way. The methods used in the states where we severally came will not be the proper methods for this country with its different soil and climate. There should be a systematic effort to study agriculture and adapted to our conditions. Many men have a prejudice against "book farming," and there is much in it certainly that will not stand the test of good horse sense, but that does not prove there is not a science of farming, and one every progressive farmer should study. We are far from an adequate solution of the kinds of crops to plant in this climate, and there is practically an infinite amount of experiment work needed to evolve the best methods of cultivating them. The railroads are charging hold up rates on freight into and out of the territory. An organized protest might hasten the breaking up of railroad domination. These and many other things might engage profitably an organizations of farmers. Let's have it and have it now.

Killing at LaLande.

C. A. Peck, a citizen of LaLande, was killed at that place last Saturday, by Ed Harwell, another citizen. The killing took place at four o'clock in the afternoon and was enacted in the middle of the business street of the little town. Mr. Harwell was a saloon keeper there until recently when his saloon was burned. Mr. Peck was formerly a citizen of Oklahoma, having come to LaLande early in the life of the town. He was an enterprising business man engaged in the real estate business. Mr. Harwell was brought over to the county jail Monday by sheriff

Curry ordered a special police to proceed to Taos and place him under guard.

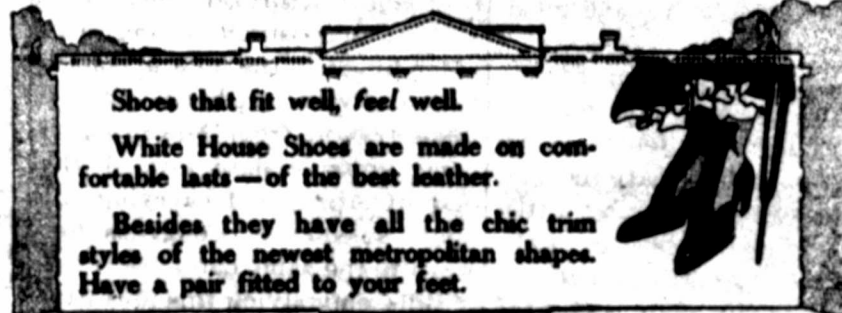
