## Historical Sketch

As early as 1899, the Portaies Common School ma be said to have begun. The first school was not at al pretentious, but it served its purpose. The first buila ing was nothing more than an old railroad shop and was located not far from the present depot. since the
various arrangements as to buildings have been made. Until 1907, a small frame building located near the pres ent building was used. As the school became mor crowded other houses in the neighborhood were com pelled to be used to accommodate the ever increasin attendance. Beginning with 1908, the new school build ing, erected at a cost of $\$ 16,000$, was available, and al
though it was sufficiently large at the time built, Por ales has grown so fast that even now the problem of new building to accommodate either the Common Schoo or the High School is before us.
