An act for the protection of minors and pupils in schools. C. B. No. 1, approved Feb. 18, 1901. <br> Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to sell or give to any minor under the age of 18 years, or to any pupil of any school or educational institution within this territory any intoxicating liquor or any cigars, cigarettes, or tobacco in any form, except upon the written consent of the parent or guardian of such minor or pupil. <br> Sec. 2. It shall be unlawful for any merchant, apothecary, saloon keeper, or the proprietor or manager of any other establishment in which intoxicating liquors or tobacco in any form are kept or offered for sale, to permit any minor under the age of 18 years, or pupil in any school or educational institution to engage in any play or game of chance with cards, dice, wheels, or by any manipulation of any machinery or device by means of which money or any commodity or property may be hazarded, won or lost, acquired or transferred. <br> Sec. 3. It shall be unlawful for any proprietor, keeper or manager of any saloon where intoxicating liquor is kept or offered for sale, or where gambling in any form is carried on or permitted, to permit any minor under the age of 21 years or any pupil in any school or educational institution, to loiter upon or frequent the premises belonging to such saloon, or to engage in games or | Hamilton \& Brown's Ladies' Children's and men's shoes.
