### B. RUPPE ON R. R.

"You people are not very enthusiastic over the railroad that is headed for Portales," remarked B. Ruppe, the territorial official who was here Tuesday checking up the druggists on the side of justice. "You see that map? Well, the road is right on that line, and will be continued on down that way to Brouillette and across there to Portales," he remarked as he traced the map of New Mexico in the Times office. From Brouillette to the mouth of Abo Canyon, a distance of 20 miles the contractors have laid the track to transport supplies and material for the heavy work in the canyon, which is about four miles long with perpendicular walls of rock from 200 to 500 feet high and only wide enough at the bottom for a wagon road and from 200 to 300 feet wide at the top. At the mouth of the canyon in the far distant past, there was evidently at one time a momentous subterranean disturbance, even surpassing the one in Kentucky. After passing through the canyon as one goes east he enters the Abo valley, which is an open valley to the summit 16 miles distant. The line passes about one mile south of Abo ruins, which are about five miles above the canyon. Notwithstanding the Abo valley and canyon embrace a water shed or drainage area of about 250 square miles there is usually very little if any water flowing through the canyon. But at times the volume of water that pours through it is not to be scoffed at by the contractors. At the summit of the pass or valley, 40 miles by railroad line from Brouillette, the land is on the western verge of an extensive plain covered with fine gramma grass and groves of cedar and pine. For a century it has been the sheep herders' paradise. Here at the summit, the first dirt cut was made, one mile long and 35 feet deep, containing 162,000 cubic yards of dirt. The grade is about 73 feet to the mile in the valley, but from the summit east to the grade is not above 35 feet to the mile.
