According o our opinion one of the best be to commer could do woulc nake preparations to have his ground in proper shape for planting when the time comes. If and deep just as soon as it got dry enough after the wet spell in the early part of the winter, then gone over with a subsurface packer, and then lightly harowed and reharrowed after each hower, we believe a condition of that would he in been secure that would be in good shape for planting to corn very early this spring. Ground put in thateondition would bring the corn up early and hold enough moisture o keep the plant growing. Each shower would boost it along, and the gtound could be harrowed after each shower till the plants got so big the harrow vould injure them. Corn planed in this way would have very nuch the advantage of corn plantedoon gronnd that is not plowed till the spring rains se in, especially if they happen to start in rather late
