NOTICE OF ROAD BOND

TO THE RESIDENT QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF COMMISSIONERS' PRECINCT NO. 2 OF CASTRO COUNTY, TEXAS, WHO OWN TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID PRECINCT AND WHO HAVE DULY RENDERED THE SAME FOR TAXATION: TAKE NOTICE that an election will be held on the 22nd day of June, 1946, within the COMMISSIONERS' PRECINCT NUMBER 2, OF CASTRO COUNTY, TEXAS, to determine if said Precinct shall issue bonds, and if an annual ad valorem tax shall be levied annually on all taxable property within said Precinct sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity.

ON THIS 22nd day of May, 1946, the Commissioners' Court of Castro County, Texas, being in special session, there being present and in attendance the following members of the Court, at the regular meeting place thereof in the Courthouse at Dimmitt, Texas, to-wit: EUGENE L.
