During my practice there I was very losely confined and felt that a vacation would do me good. decided to spend my vacalion assisting in same.
In the fall of 1917, about the time I was contemplating going back to Kentucky to take up my work again, I was aske dto aceept an appointment on the Local Board for this ounty, in which capacity I served as member and chairman until the Board was excused from further duty, At the expiration of these services I was requested by the physicians f this city to take the State Board examination of this state and practice in
decided to do so.

When I first entered the optical profession I praciced under competent instruction for a period of five years and then went to the Bradley Polytechnic Institute, Peoria,
IL, at which place I took their full course in the Horological Department, including Optometry, receiving my diploma from this institution with the elass of 1908, During my attendance at this institution I was assistant in the optical work, being
