

### BRITISH ATTEMPT TO BREAK THRU NAZI LINES TO PLAINS OF TUNIS IS CONTINUING

NORTH AFRICA, April 30. — Massed German tanks and infantry, battling desperately to prevent an Allied break-through onto the Tunis plain, hammered incessantly yesterday at newly-won British positions on the Medjez El Bab front, but apart from one small gain were repulsed everywhere, a communique announced today.

While the British First Army absorbed some of the heaviest Axis attacks since the start of the battle of Tunisia, the Second U. S. Army Corps in the north and the British Eighth CLEANUP TO Army in the southeast inched forward in local

(An Italian communique broadcast by the Rome Radio said renewed Allied attempts to NEXT WEEK force Axis lines were frustrated by the "valorous" Italo-German defense).

(The German Trans-Ocean News Agency said that 38 British and American armored vehicles had been destroyed in the Mediez El Bab fighting, boosting to 51 the number of Allied tanks destroyed in that area. Nazi giant Mark Six tanks were participating, the broadcast said, and had destroyed 25 Allied tanks.

(The British Radio reported from Tunisia that the Axis was still sending supplies and men to Tunisia, moving them across the Sicilian Straits on moonless nights)

Allied planes and light coastal forces, teaming in new attacks aimed at whittling down the enemy's sea and air power, sank at least four ships in the Sicilian narrows and Gulf of Tunis, and shot down 16 aircraft.

Front dispatches said that the British at one time Wednesday reached the crest of Djebel Bou Aoukaz, only to be thrown back slightly by a heavy German attack.

Today's Allied communique said bitter fighting continued throughout yesterday on the First Army front.

"With the exception of one small gain in the Medjerda area, all attacks were repulsed with heavy loss to the enemy, and our forward positions were maintained," the communique






