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TOO MUCH SECRECY.

If war, navy and state department officials would express publicly their fears and their knowledge of the weapons of a future war, United States citizens would realize anew the urgency for the establishment of a workable world peace. Two writers in the New York Herald-Tribune, Joseph and Steward Alsop, claim that the strategic meaning of the atom bomb as well as other new devices of warfare is being kept from the American people. Only a select few are deemed worthy of confidence.

The war department has prepared a report, heretofore kept secret, these writers say, which lists not only new uses for the bomb, but additional developments in chemical warfare, including air-borne bacteria that would poison all plant and animal life and would cause widespread epidemics. If America knows about such things, so will other countries.

In the event of another war the United States would be in the most dangerous position possible, owing to its governmental structure, which deprives it of the defense of surprise attack; its many large cities which are peculiarly vulnerable to air attack, and our tendency to quick return to peacetime complacency and national negligence, as at the present time.

Many will agree that it is a mistake for officials to withhold known facts of science's developing war weapons. For the same reason, there is much to be said for the plea of those UNO delegates who want devastated cities left for all to see. One good way to make mankind realize it cannot afford another holocaust is to truthfully advertise what one war has done to earth-dwellers, and what another can do.

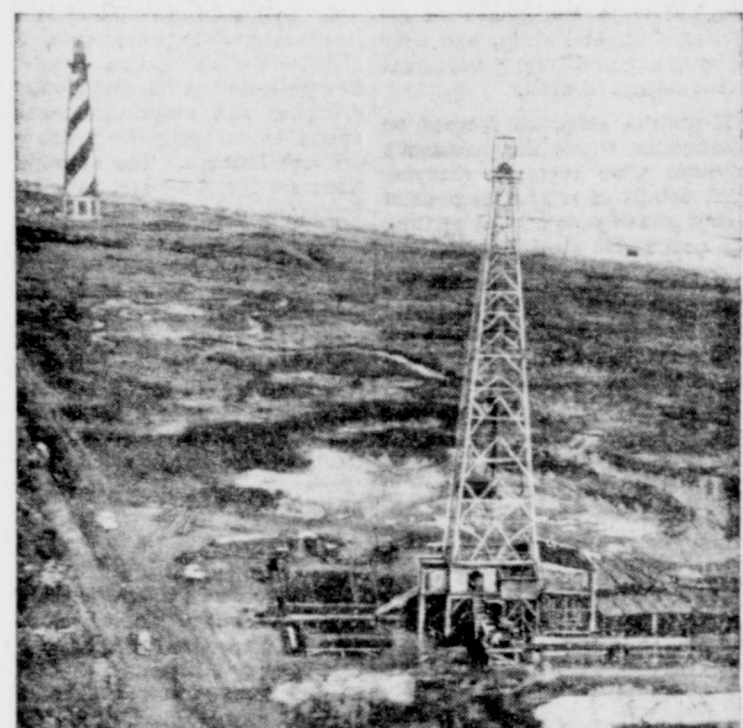

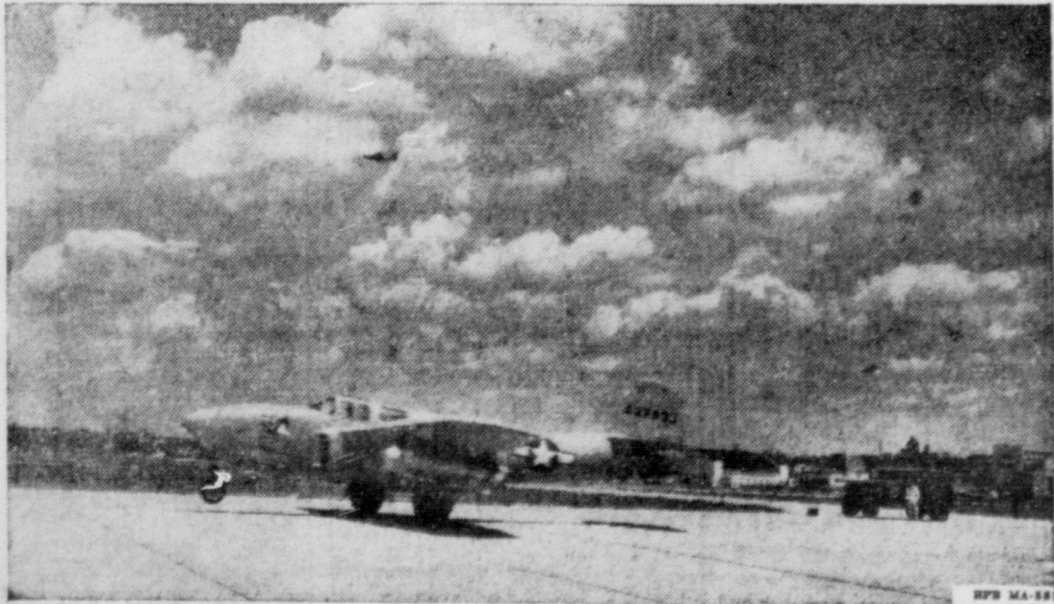
