Big Drive Wednesday Added $\$ 5,000,00$ To Right of-Way Fund; But We Like $\$ 5,000.00$ Being Over the Top-Must Be Raised Before Saturday Night If Committee Signs Contract With Fort Worth \& Denver South Plains Railway Company

Eight teams, comprising about forty men and women spent the day Wednesday in visiting the people over the Lockney country getting money and right-of-way subseribed for the Fort Worth \& Denver South Plains Railway, and they only got one-half the amount necessary to inish the subscriptions so that the railway committee could be able to sign the contract with the company. Thi amount of notes ( $\$ 5,000.00$ more) must be in the hands of the committee by Saturday night, as that is the date for
winding up the contract, so that the Denver people can winding up the contract, so that the Denver people can
be notified that we are ready to sign the contract. Nearly $\$ 25,000.00$ has been signed up, and it will take $\$ 30,000.00$ to take care of the expense of securing the right-of-way so it is thought by members of the railroad committee, an the committee is not willing to sign up for the road unti $\$ 30,000.00$ worth of notes are in the hands of the trustees In Wednesday's drive most of those approached signed up for some amount, however, some men turned the committees down, and did not sign at all.. Every person should feel that it is his or her duty to help secure this line of railroad, and if it is at all possible for them to subscribe any amount to the right-of-way fund, should come in vol untarily and do so. It is just as much to the interest of on property owner as another to secure this line, and it is also to the interest of every tenant or laborer to help secure the second railroad through the town and country, and it is not a donation the man who subscribes is making, but is an investment that will bring him big returns. The securing of the railroad will mean the first year it is in operation a saving of more in freight rates than the amount we are to raise to buy right-of-way with; to the farmer i
will mean a saving on every ton of maize, bale of cotton bushel of wheat, or pound of poultry that he sends out, be sides it will increase the value of his land and make it more sides it will increase the value of his land and make it more saleable if he desires to sell, and it will give him better transportation facilities and a shorter haul to the better markets he wants to reach. To the town man it will mean that it will help build up the town, create more labor using businesses and industries, make the living expenses cheaper by reason of lowering the freight rates, make wages bet ter by reason of being more jobs to work; increase the value of property and help in a thousand ways to mak The committees are still working on the job, and the The committees are still working on the job, and they

We expect to publish the list of those who have contributed in our next issue if the subscription is raised, and we hope that the name of every business organization in town will be in that list, as well as the name of every farmer for a radius of several miles on each side of the Denver line clear across Floyd County.
