### Gas prices inflating as temps shrink

Sky-rocketing natural gas prices are putting the squeeze on nearly everyone's budget this winter, and the poor and elderly may literally get left out in the cold.

Roy Urrutia of Lubbock, public affairs manager for this area's natural gas supplier, Energas Co., has said that natural gas market prices are continuing to increase.

Wholesale natural gas prices nation-wide are continuing to increase, along with the wholesale costs of heating oil, propane and other energy sources, according to a news release from Energas.

"Last December the cost of natural gas was \$2.50 per hundred cubic foot (ccf), while this year it is now almost \$9 per ccf," Urrutia said Tuesday.

This increase, along with colder than normal weather, means that customers' heating bills will be significantly higher than in 1999.

Based on current gas price projections, the average residential customer's peak winter bill may increase 50% to 100% or more over last winter, using the same units of

consumption. There is help-temporarily-for those who are financially unable to pay the higher utility bills.

Panhandle Community Services at 110 SW Second in Dimmitt can help in three ways, but only for a short time, according to Stella Devers,

PCS center coordinator for Dimmitt.

"We have a lot of money available to help, but only through Dec. 28," Devers said. She said the agency's funding ends that day and it is unknown when money will be available for the new year. It depends on the legislature.

The three ways PCS can help are to actually pay an applicant's heating bills (gas or electric), pay for repairs to a faulty heating system or for replacement of an unvented heater with a wall heater, or to pay for weatherization work (weather stripping, insulation, etc.) on a home to make it more economical to heat.

Any repair or replacement work must be authorized by Dec. 28, even though the work may not be completed by that date.

Those seeking help must meet income eligibility guidelines, Devers said. For more information, call her at 647-3244.

"Our elderly clients are scared to death," Devers said. "They are facing a major increase (in heating costs) and they live on a tight budget. They are asking, 'What can I do?'

'They haven't had to make a choice between food or heat yet, but they may have to in January," she said. "It doesn't look good as far as our funding being in place by Janu-

Devers said PCS has an agreement with Energas. If a person is unable to pay their bill and qualifies for help, then PCS notifies Energas that PCS will pay the bill for that person, and Energas agrees not to disconnect that customer for non-payment.

However, Devers said that Energas has been slow in responding to PCS's notifications and some clients have been disconnected anyway. Then, when they are already having difficulty paying, the customer is faced with paying a deposit and a reconnect fee.

"Part of the problem is that PCS has to talk to someone in Amarillo (to stop the disconnect process), and before Amarillo can notify (the service personnel in) Hereford, the service gets disconnected," said Dimmitt Mayor Wayne Collins, who also is a member of the PCS board of directors.

"It's regrettable that we're going the way we're going (toward centralization and no personal contact), but it seems to be an irreversible trend in our society," Collins said.

Wednesday morning, Collins said he had spoken with personnel at the Hereford Energas office and was told that an effort would be made to make a refund of extra fees to any customers who may have gotten disconnected after the notice to continue service was posted.

The Texas Railroad Commission recently adopted an emergency rule that can stop discontinuance of natural gas service during winter months. However, the rule is enforceable only in the rural areas of a county unless it is adopted by individual cities. The City of Dimmitt has not adopted the rule-vet.

"We may talk about it at the next meeting of the city council," Collins said. "Energas had assured us they

Once an Energas customer is past due on a payment, they will receive a termination notice, according to Urrutia. Then a second notification is given by a tag placed on the customer's door. If there is no response to either notice, service is disconnected.

"If the temperature is 32 or below, we will suspend action as far as turning anybody off," Urrutia told Karla Abernethy-Thetford of The Canyon News staff as reported in an article in the Dec. 17 issue. "We will pursue with notices, but we won't turn anybody off."

If service is disconnected for nonpayment, a customer must pay a \$50 deposit and a reconnect fee. It costs \$29.50 to be reconnected during regular office hours or \$39 for after

hours service, according to Urrutia. Collins said he was told that there is a \$10.50 service charge if the door

tag has to be placed. "We want our customers to be aware of the higher gas prices, so that they can plan for higher gas bills

and adjust their budgets accordingly," said Tom Hawkins, president of Energas. "We also want our customers to know that the sale of natural gas is not a source of income for our company. Changes in natural gas prices-either up or down-are passed through to customers on their monthly gas bill."

He said the company's revenues are derived from the cost of providing service, and state regulators,

through rate filings, set these rates. "We also share our customers' hopes that natural gas prices will soon return to lower levels in the near future," Hawkins said.

Energas blames the increase in natural gas prices on:

◆ Greater demand for natural gas. Summer demand for natural gas increased due to its use in gas-fired electric generating plants. Industrial growth also has increased the demand for natural gas.

◆ Colder than normal weather

being experienced. Higher energy prices. Gasoline, home heating oil, and crude oil prices also are contributing to the rise in natural gas prices.

♦ Less exploration and production.. Natural gas exploration and production declined in 1998 and 1999 due to mild winter weather and low prices at the well head. While current levels of exploration and production are high, forecasters have factored this into current and future gas prices.

Customers are advised to conserve energy and take necessary steps to lower their heating bills. Thermostat setting and the energy efficiency of customers' homes and heating equipment can affect gas consumption and the impact of higher gas prices. Setting a natural gas water heater temperature to 120 degrees, or "medium," for example, can lower a customer's gas bill without sacrificing comfort.

To offset the impact of higher gas prices and cold winter weather, Energas says that its customers may choose to enroll in the company's "Budget Billing" program, which offers a way to even out monthly gas bill payments. To learn more about this program or to ask about alternative payment arrangements, customers may call toll free 1-888-363-7427, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

"We are asking customers to call beforehand if they find they will need a payment plan," Urrutia said.

Customers may want to call to verify a correct reading of their meter or if they want to make a comparison with their usage levels a year

"We have been having quite an influx of calls, so you may have a better chance of getting through if you call at other than peak hours," Urrutia said. He said the busiest times are all day Monday and Friday, during business hours, and 8 a.m. to noon on other week days. After regular business hours and on weekends are the least busy.

"They are trying at the call center to handle calls as quickly as they can," Urrutia said.

In a side note, agricultural producers also are being hard hit by increased natural gas prices, especially those who use natural gas to power their irrigation engines.

Area rural electric cooperatives have said they are getting a lot of inquiries from producers thinking about switching from gas to electric.

Deaf Smith Electric Cooperative has had a significant number who have already signed up to make the switch.

"I estimate about 90 different customers are on current work orders, but I'm not sure how many meters that represents," said Tommie Weemes, the manager of member services for DSEC. "We will take care of them as fast as we can, but that represents about two years of work that we're trying to do in a twomonth period.

He estimated that the work will take 63 miles of overhead line and 25 miles of underground line.

Weemes said most of the switchover is due to higher natural gas

"On smaller horsepower engines, electricity is definitely more economical," said Mike Ferguson, member services advisor for Swisher Electric Cooperative. He said his company has received some inquiries and he expects more action on the matter after the conclusion of the ginning season.


In conjunction with the new South Plains Cluster Court, CASA has received a grant from the Governor's office to expand its services into the 11 counties covered by the cluster

This collaborative expansion will provide for a CASA volunteer to be appointed to all the children in CPS care in the cluster court area

Judge Kelly Moore, administrative judge for the Ninth Judicial Region, said, "When I learned that a court had been approved for 11 counties in this area, my first thought was that we might be able to facilitate the expansion of CASA into all 11 counties. I cannot stress enough the importance of the CASA program to the children.'

CASA is a nationwide program that provides volunteers to advocate for the best interests of abused and neglected children in the court system. CASA volunteers conduct interviews and do research regarding their cases and then make written and verbal recommendations to the judge. They help ensure that the children are put in the best situation possible.







### Cotton talks

By SHAWN WADE

With the finality of the presidential election process fresh on their minds, High Plains cotton growers are looking for a little finality of their own in regard to the 2000 growing season.

With a majority of the details known for the 2000 Crop Disaster Program (CDP), producers wavering over the decision to abandon or harvest marginal acreage can now closely estimate program benefits they would be eligible for under wither scenario.

final determination of applicable early and late non-harvest factors that will be applied to CDP benefits paid on failed acreage.

Most guesswork at this time indicates acreage failed early in the growing season will have CDP benefits factored down by 25 to 30%. Acres carried significantly farther into the growing season will probably be factored down at a lower rate, probably between 10 and 15%.

It should also be noted that there is still authority for a "severe economic loss" program available for future consideration by the next administration. Efforts to bring about additional assistance through this legislative window will continue as well.

Concerns now include finding ways to implement some immediate economic relief that will help growers project positive cash flows and allow the financing of operating loans for 2001.

> The 2001 growing season holds some of the most significant challenges yet for growers. PCG and the National Cotton Council are already working to develop game plans for attacking these challenges to the benefit of all cotton producers.

> The investment to support organizations such as PCG and the NCC have been repaid many times over through benefits paid to producers.

> Worth remembering as well is that the 2000 crop Cottonseed Assistance Program is expected to bring producers some \$5 to \$6 per bale in additional support early next year. The final payment rate will be determined after all bales have been ginned.
