eration, by the State Highway Department and the Commissioners Court of Floyd County, because we recognize the fact the authorities have to have a beginning place and a program to work from. The Highway Department of the State of Texas pledges the State to (1) Handle all engineering; (2) To make the oad contracts and supervise all work; (3) To maintain the hard surfaced roads that are built; and (4) to pay one-fourth of the construction costs. This means that the county will get the benefit of the services and the partnership of the Greatest Road Building and Maintenance Organization in our nation at half price. Fortunately Floyd County Property Valuations for Taxes are Low Regardless of what part of the county our lands are situated.
With total valuations slightly over $\$ 10$ million ( $\$ 10$,000,000 ) there is not a piece of Farm Land in the County, regardless of how highly developed, that is valued at more than $\$ 9$ per acre for taxation purposes. Some of it carries a tax valuation of $\$ 8$ per acre, some $\$ 7$ per acre and our rough land is on the tax rolls at $\$ 2$ to $\$ 2.50$ per acre. Town property is also val ued most reasonably for the county and state ad valorem tax. At these values the bond issue to take care of the county's part of the program would be not to exceed $\$ 11.52$ per year on the highest-priced section ol land in the county and would scale down to $\$ 2.56$ per section on rough land.
Please check these figures before you decide that they are wrong.
