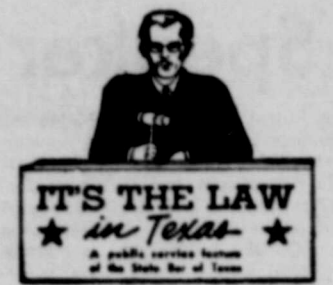

You will find strange words in the U. S. Constitution: "Congress has the power to define and punish piracies and felonies committed on the high seas, and offenses against the law of nations." No man owns the high seas, and no nation rules it. So that when a crime like piracy takes place, the law does not look upon it as against any one nation, but against the law of nations.

For centuries, all maritime nations have had the right under international law to capture on the high seas gully piratical acts and to punish them. Piracy is an international crime, but each country punishes it under its own laws. Any nation has the right and duty to police the high seas, and any pirate loses the protection of the flag he may be flying. As one court put it, the pirate is "treated as an outlaw, as an enemy of all mankind." How far this idea of the "enemy of mankind" may go, is now a question before world opinion. The treaty of Versailles, for example, held that Germans who had broken the law and customs of war should go to trial before the courts of the victors.

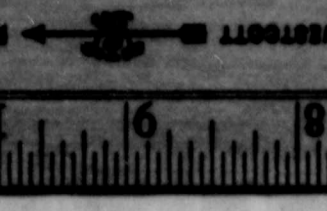

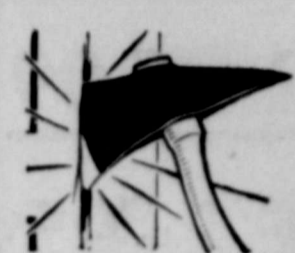
Mrs Sutton Is Hostess to WMU Circle Monday

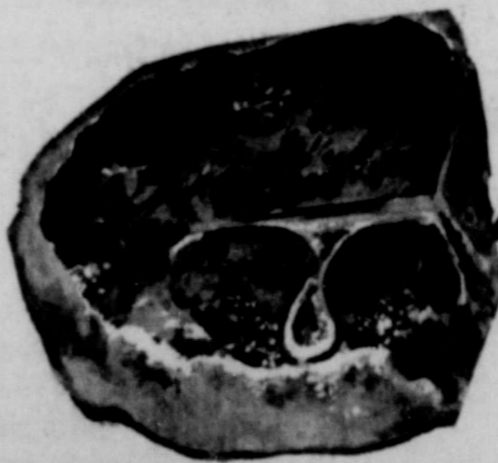
