Both Martin and Frisch stole second but Earnshaw tightened up each time and the runners were unable to advance beyond second base.

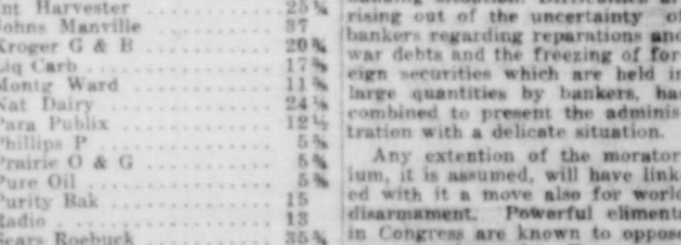
MORATORIUM OF TWO YEARS SEEMS EMINENT

Present Price of Cotton Disastrous Commissioner Says

Commissioner of Agriculture... The probable disaster... present prices were pointed out...

"With present prices for agricultural crops, the farmer is left without buying power so vitally necessary to sustain government, commerce, transportation, schools and society. All must suffer. Such prices mean bankruptcy and despair, and all this when there is so abundant production."

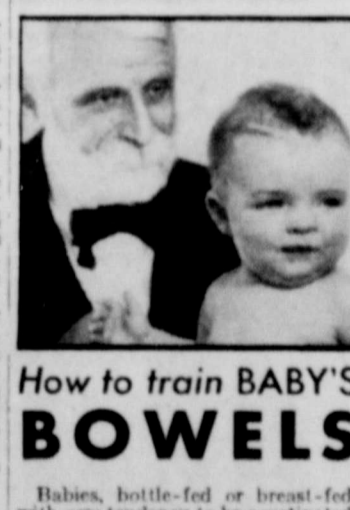
