**NOTICE OF HEARING ON PETITION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF ROAD BONDS BY COMMISSIONERS' PRECINCT NO. 2, OF CASTRO COUNTY, TEXAS**

THE STATE OF TEXAS, COUNTY OF CASTRO.

To the voters of Precinct No. 2, Castro County, Texas, and all other persons concerned:

TAKE NOTICE that a petition signed by Sid Sheffy and more than fifty (50) other persons, as resident property taxpayers voters of COMMISSIONERS' PRECINCT NUMBER 2, a political subdivision of CASTRO COUNTY, TEXAS, has heretofore been submitted to the Commissioners' Court of said County, wherein such petitioners assert that they desire the Court to order an election to be held in said COMMISSIONERS' PRECINCT NUMBER 2, for the purpose of submitting the following proposition to the qualified resident property taxpayers voters of said Precinct, for their action thereupon:

"WHETHER OR NOT the bonds of COMMISSIONERS' PRECINCT NUMBER 2, a political subdivision of CASTRO COUNTY, TEXAS, shall be issued in the total principal sum of \$200,000.00, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, gravelled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, and which bonds are to bear interest at a rate not exceeding 2 1/2% per annum, and are to be payable at such times as may be deemed most expedient by the Commissioners' Court, but not to exceed 20 years from the date thereof; and that at such election there shall also be submitted to the qualified resident property taxpayers voters of the said COMMISSIONERS' PRECINCT NUMBER 2, the question as to whether or not ad valorem taxes shall be levied on all taxable property within the said COMMISSIONERS' PRECINCT NUMBER 2, for the purpose of paying the interest on the said bonds and to provide a sinking fund for the redemption or payment thereof at maturity."

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the aforesaid petition stipulates that if the said bonds are voted and issued, the money received from the sale thereof will be applied to the construction and maintenance of—

I. A road beginning at the North East corner of Section 4, Block 0-3, Castro County, Texas; Thence South along the East line of Block 0-3, E. L. & RR RY Co. Survey, Castro County, Texas and the East line of Block 0-4, D & SE RY Co.
