Already the civil war in Spain is more than a civil war, and is rapidly becoming an actual conflict between two opposing concepts of social organization...

Germany and Japan form an anti-Communist alliance, and it is openly hinted that they will go to war in the spring. Britain arms with feverish haste...

No American can contemplate that prospect without prayerfully asking what his own country's course should be when the break-up begins...

We can, if we insist upon it; we should, if we can.

In 1916 we heard a great deal of hifalutin talk to the effect that we owed a high duty to the rest of the world, that it was somehow ignoble and unworthy for us to sit peacefully at home...

We ought to prepare our defenses ahead of time. Let us get it clearly in our heads that if Europe goes to war again, we can best serve the world by staying at peace...

If we can put ourselves in shape to resist the war propaganda, the material part of the job ought to be easier. We can resolve not to let our land be turned into a source of supply for either side...

We can make ourselves see that no matter how painful might be the industrial depression which a European war would create in America, the remedy of a war-made boom would be a cure worse than the disease.

It is not too soon for us to begin thinking earnestly about these things. The European catastrophe may take shape overnight. The time to make our desire for peace effective is now...
