The Commissioners Court of Castro County Has Called An Election for October 21, 1958 In Which To Submit the Following Two Propositions To the Voters of Castro County:

PROPOSITION NO. 1:

AUTHORIZING THE LEVY OF AN ADDITIONAL SPECIAL 30c AD VALOREM TAX AS PROVIDED IN HOUSE BILL 107, ACTS OF THE 51st LEGISLATURE:

Should the proposition of authorizing the special .30¢ Ad Valorem tax be passed by the voters of Castro County and become effective in the 1959 tax year, the Commissioners Court will, at the same time, lower the county valuations sufficiently to off set the increased rate. In other words the cost to each individual tax payer on his county, state, water district, and precinct no. 2 road taxes (all levied on county valuation) will be no greater than it has been in the past and in many instances the cost will be considerably lowered.

From the examples below you will note that the total savings to each tax payer will vary from a few cents to 17% of his total tax due on the county, state, water district, and precinct no. 2 road levies. The reason that the savings to each tax payer will vary will be due to the type of property, homestead exemptions, and whether or not the real estate is located in precinct no. 2.

The 30¢ special tax proposed herein will not be levied against the homestead exemption granted to each taxpayer

since the special levy will be figured on the state tax value of your property. This proposal has been checked by the county auditor and has been declared by him to produce a total savings to the taxpayers of Castro County in the amount of \$5744.26 and at the same time increase county revenue by \$4952.63. Many other counties over the state have adopted this plan.

With the 30¢ special tax adopted and with all county valuations reduced 17½% for the year 1959 the following are examples taken from the 1958 tax rolls showing what the 1958 totals amount to now as compared to what the 1959 totals would be after this plan is put into operation.

Note: This proposal **does not** in any way affect the school or city taxes.

The final effect this proposal will have on the tax rolls of the county, state, water district, and special road district no. 2 are as follows:

Castro County has not had a general increase in taxes since 1946. THIS PROPOSAL IS NOT AN INCREASE.

Castro County had only a re-evaluation of property in 1955 (where one item of property went up in valuation there was a corresponding decrease in another item.)

The increased cost of county government operation and addition of county hospital costs have been paid for by the addition to the tax rolls of new homes, businesses, and personal property.


