Poultry And Egg Shipments Drop

AUSTIN, Tex. —Shipments of poultry and eggs from Texas stations during September were far below those of September a year ago, the University of Texas Bureau of Business Research has reported.
In September, 1942, a total of 11 carloads of dressed poultry were shipped from Texas stations, as compared with 22 carloads during the same month of 1941. Shipments of eggs, stated in terms of the shell egg equivalent for frozen and dried eggs, amounted to 509 carloads in September of this year, while in September, 1941, 546 carloads were shipped.

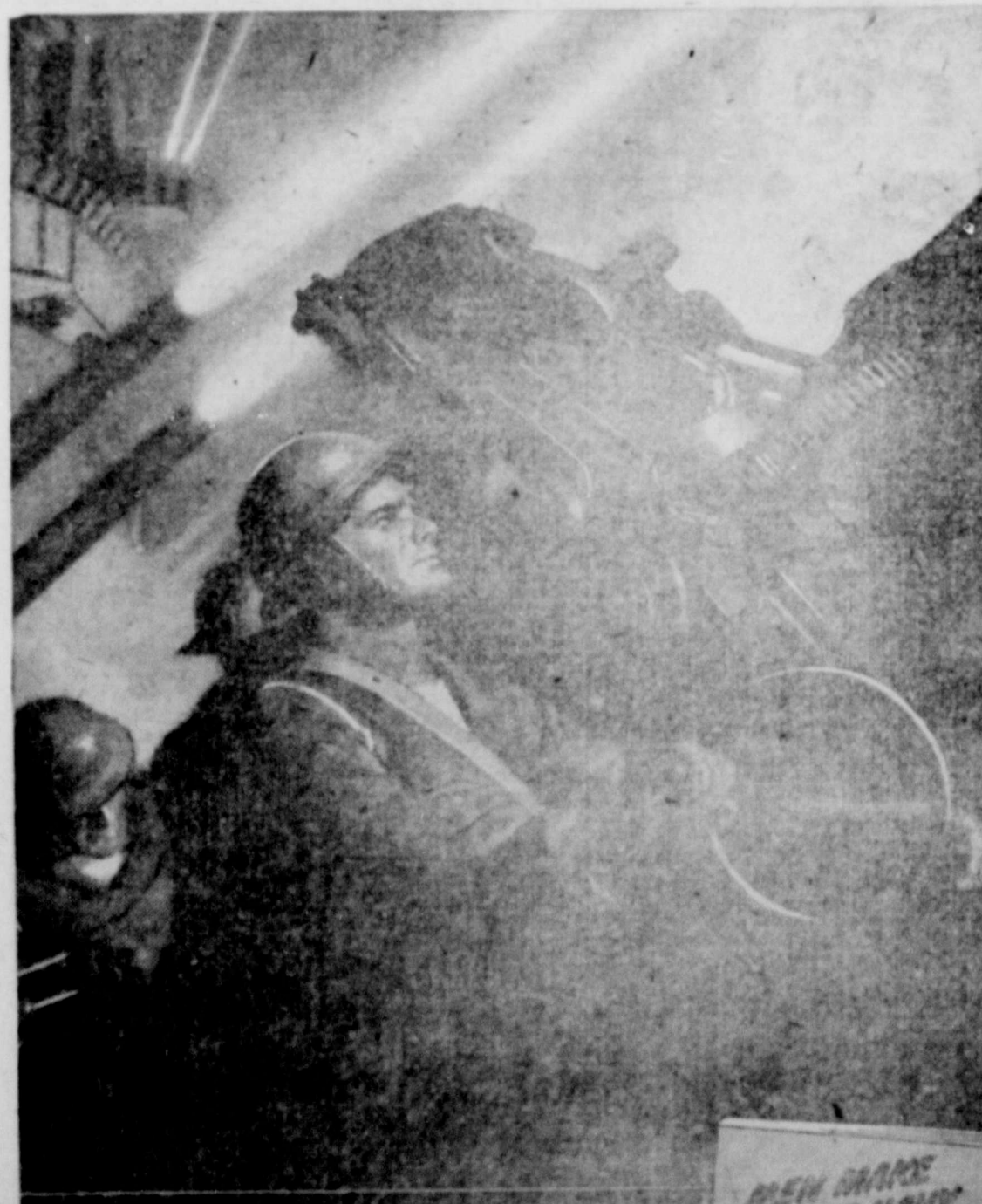
