Constellation Is Preview Of Post War Planes

BURBANK, Cal (UP)—Even the nation's No. 1 airliner must temporarily put off civilian life until the war is won.

The new Lockheed Constellation, now adopted by the Army as the brainchild of sportsman pilot Howard Hughes, who first sketched it on his drafting board back in 1939 for Transcontinental and Western Airlines.

This new superliner offers post war air transportation with all facilities for first class travel. The cabin will be pressurized to keep ground level comfort of hearing and breathing even at an altitude of 36,000 feet. At this height 90 per cent of the weather disturbances can be overcome, and most any weather will be "flying weather."

This giant will loaf onto the flying strip at a landing speed of only 80 miles per hour. Special

flaps make extremely short landing distance possible.

Compared with the DC-3, the present popular commercial passenger ship, the Constellation's 123-foot wing spread is 28 feet longer than the rival; body length of 95 feet is 30 1/2 feet longer, and horsepower is 8,800 as against 2,400 of the DC-3.

The Constellation will take its 57 passengers and crew of seven across the continent from Los Angeles to New York in something less than 10 hours.

With Washington as home base, one will be able to go to London in 13 1/2 hours, or to Tokyo in 28 hours. These distances are so close because the Constellation will follow the course of the great circle, instead of the traditional geographical routes. To reach the Orient it will fly in a northwest direction.

High altitude flying will eliminate many overnight stops heretofore necessary on runs to Latin America. Before the war it took nearly 71 hours to go from Kansas City to Rio de Janeiro, a distance of 7,592 miles. The Constellation will make the trip in approximately 29 hours.

Best commercial schedules before the war made the jump from Kansas City to Fairbanks, Alaska, in 72 hours. The new Lockheed liner will cut the time to less than 14 hours.

America is in for big things in aviation, and the Constellation
