Rubber Decovs Used ToFcol Enemy On D-Day



One of the most facinating stories of World War II was disclosed by the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Co., upon the lifting of the striclest Army and Navy censorship, which prevailed for the past four years. It is the story of the production and use of balloon fabric, inflatable replicas of Army and Navy warmaterial, employed to deceive the enemy p revious to D-Day, Instead of the use of cam-ouflage in wartime for concealment, Army and Navy made use of artifices prod-uced by Goodyear at Akron, Ohio to delib with other commodities, it sho erately entice the enemy into observing, and sometimes bombing and strafing comparati vely inexpensive rubber and fabric objects, while our real armor and fighting craft, un scathed, were preparing to attack from an other, unexpected angle. Fabric boats, barg es, folded up and shipped to the scene of ac-tion with the loss of practically no carggo sp ace, were inflated to full scale so that from the air they resembled originals. Tanks, tank destroyers, heavy artillery, landing craft of all sorts, PT boats and many other units were similarly made up to provide the re-quired deception. In the above photo, U. 


