


## Humorist to speak at Chamber **Banquet next Thursday night**

## Two hospital board members seek re-election April 2 election

In a regular monthly Thursday night meeting of the hospital board, all members and the administrator were present the night of February 24. In old business the board discussed and made plans for the upcoming election on Saturday, April 2. The polis will be located at the east entrance of Lockney High School at 410 S.W. 4th Street, with the hospital district and the school district sharing the same centralized place to vote.

In the administrator's monthly report a total of \$54,000 of previously charged January, but inpatients had increased to 12 a day for a month. In other data given in the administrator's report a department by department report was given, clinically and administratively.

In new business covered by the board a financial and statistical report for January showed an operating loss for the hospital of \$11,661 compared to a loss of \$14,263 for January of 1982.

Year-to-date operating loss for the period from October, 1982 through January, 1983 is at \$53,819. The same period in 1982 showed a loss of \$80,000. for an improvement of \$26,247 for the first four-month period of the physical year. This year's YTD was an improvement of \$13,080 over 2 years ago. Figures are based on hospital revenue

# **Sterley Elevator collapses**

No one was injured when a storage tank at the Sterley Elevator collapsed about 3:00 a.m. Wednesday morning. A falling wall of the tank knocked down a power line and power was out in the surrounding area for about one hour.

the foundation, causing a pressure wall to pull away from the foundation. Pressure inside caused the walls to collapse

In 1979 a tornado had dented a wall of the elevator, causing only minor damage to the tank which had been repaired and approved.

Several parts of the tank are salvageable including roof trusses and several fans and motors. Some of the bottom fans have not been found yet.

off accounts have been sent to a collection agency in Dallas, Hospital Receivables Service. Administrator Guy Hazlett also announced that delinquent accounts amounting to \$36,000 have been sent notices. The near \$90,000 of accounts receivable in the 538 delinquent accounts are almost eligible for charge off, according to new credit and collection procedures. They are being worked extensively.

Fees for Health Fitness Center was recommended by the administrator to be decreased from \$30 to \$20 per person per month.

Outpatient visits to the hospital fell sharply due to the bad weather in

January's collections increased over that of November and December. Because the board meeting was held later in the month, February figures indicated that \$41,042 had been billed and \$53,354 had been collected, for a 129% collections on the amount billed. Also in the financial and statistical report for January the equivalent of 55 fulltime employees was shown for the hospital district.

As a result of the collapse, 24 million moved to other elevators around the county for storage.

According to Gail Kring, manager of Lockney Coops, estimated damage to the tank is between \$250,000 and \$300,000. Cause of the collapse will not be determined until all of the corn has been removed and engineers can examine all the parts of the tank.

Kring said that the suspected cause of the collapse was that the foundation gave way under the tank due to extended wet weather having weakened



portable, making it available to any part of the hospital in a matter of seconds. It could be made available in patient's room upon request.

A patient coming into the hospital experiencing severe chest pains could be administered a more efficient service because of its capabilities. An EKG reading can be given in a few seconds with a tape readout that the doctor can study when he is summoned.

If a patient should go into cardiac arrest, a flip of a switch can engage the lifesaving equipment to defibrillating (shock). The shocking power is as equivalent to that of the large non-portable units in large operating rooms. The easy operation and synchronization capability of the unit makes it particularly desirable, as well as its dependability that has been proven in hospitals all across the United States.

The indispensable unit gave the hospital two complete lifesaving stations. One is in surgery.

A "crash cart" consists of the cardiac defibrillator and a pharmacy kit containing cardiac drugs to stimulate the heart or to control the heart rate.

Dr. Gary Mangold commented, "It is very reassuring to have this little unit. We could not ask for a better addition to our facilities."

The unit is battery operated and is left charging between uses for instant availability. The original cost for the defibrillator was \$6500, but the hospital was able to secure it the \$2500.

"That's squash. Just eat the pork and do as I say.'


Pork was finally eaten, but not as much as it is today. I am sure cooking had something to do with pork being accepted. Which led to my next question: who invented cooking?
