homemaker services, therapies, medical social service, and counseling. Additionally, a broad range of outpati-
ent services and short term inpatient ent services and short term inpatient
care is also covered. become eligible for hospice care. First, one must be eligible for Medicare (Part
A) hospital insurance. Both the doctor and hospice medical director must cerrify that the patient's illness is
terminal. The patient must choose hospice instead of standard Medicare bencits. Finally, the care must be
received from a Medicare certified hospice program.
Hospice benefits periods of 90 days each and one 30 day period. A patient can choose to cancel
