### Local burglary occurs

On Tuesday, January 22, Schacht Flowers, Jewelry and Gifts was burglarized by unknown perpetrators.

Lockney, Texas 79241

Access to the store was gained by breaking the front glass door of the store with some heavy object. Glass was scattered across the width of the building to the west side. The break in was discovered by the Schachts upon opening the shop the following morn-

The perpetrators took an undetermined amount of jewelry from the display cases of the store.

The investigation of the break in is ongoing by the Lockney Police Depart-

Rumors of residential burglaries have been received, but Police Chief, Tim Thompson, stated "I have heard that they happened, but if so, they were not reported to us." Thompson said that he knew a glass had been broken out of a home week before last but to his knowledge nothing was taken from the

Neighborhoods that have watch programs may want to make an exerted effort by contacting their block captain and others in the neighborhood, and make sure someone is watching for any strange activity in the area. The neighborhood watch programs were

started in Lockney to protect the homes and citizens in Lockney.

Citizens may take certain steps to protect their homes while at work or out of town by making sure your doors and windows are locked, even if you are only going to be away from the house for a few minutes; unlocked doors invite trouble. Ask a neighbor that is home during the day to keep an eye on your home while you are at work.

In case one is away for the weekend, have a neighbor pick up newspaper thrown in your yard. Also let them use your driveway as this will give the appearance that someone is home. Use timers to have lights come on and turn off at various times during the day to give the appearance that someone is

This incident might be the provocation it takes to start a Neighborhood Watch program in your neighborhood if there is none. It serves as one of the best deterrents to crime.

A reminder in the area of permits: all door-to-door salesmen must have a permit. In case of a salesman with no permit or a questionable person, a call to the Lockney City Hall clears up the matter. Their records will reveal all current permits; permits are good for

### 4-H auction raises over \$7000 for club

The annual 4-H dinner and chemical auction has been deemed a huge success by the county agent's office. According to Richie Crow, "Farmers came out in full force and spent \$7047.00 on the chemicals auctioned off for the benefit of 4-H." Last year's auction netted about \$3000.00.

There were 106 in attendance including 4-H members and their families, farmers and their families, the county agents, and three chemical company representatives present for the catered dinner of fish, chicken, and all the trimmings catered by Danny's Fins and Hens of Lubbock.

Following the meal county agent Richie Crow welcomed all the farmers, businessmen, and their families and introduced the chemical company representatives present including Suzanne Garnsey of Monsanto, Stan Grassel of Elanco, and Don Lain of Dow.

Auctioned off by auctioneer Tom Assiter Jr. were 23 different chemicals, one \$100 gift certificate donated by the Lockney Coop, and six lots of Paymaster cotton seed. During the course of the auction several items were purchased and then resold. One 5 pound bag of Sencor by Mobay was purchased and resold six times and brought over \$600 total for the 4-H program. Also auctioned off was Kenneth Broseh's Lockney Longhorn cap which brought \$60.

The four door prizes given away during the auction were also donated to be resold. A gift box of relishes from Blair Davis Farms brought \$50.00, a 3 pound box of 4-H pecans brought \$160.00, a bottle of Orthatrol adjuvant donated by 4-H which sold for \$20.00, and a portable air tank donated by 4-H and won by Cecil Jackson who put it up for sale and repurchased it for \$65.00.

All in all it was a fun filled evening which, thanks to the farmers and businessmen, grossed more money for the county 4-H program than has ever been raised before.

### Options seminar offered

In the scant decade or so since 1973, the financial world has witnessed an explosion in option products - exchange listed equity options, index options

Today a new set of risk management tools is available to control the effects of cotton price fluctuations. These new tools, options to buy or sell cotton futures contracts, open a wealth of new hedging strategies built around the new options contract. The advantage is that buyers of cotton futures options can enjoy absolute price protection in the event of unfavorable price moves, while still sharing in the economic benefits of favorable ones.

Futures contracts alone can not provide this combination of downside insurance and upside potential - only options can. The opportunities that options afford for reducing risk and/or enhancing returns make them the most versatile of all hedging instruments.

In an effort to help producers better understand options a seminar will be held February 12, 1985 at the Lockney High School in the Ag building beginning at 6:30 until 10:00. All interested persons are urged to attend to help themselves to understand the options alternation. ### 76,000 bales ginned in Lockney area

With only three of nine area gins through ginning this year's cotton crop the bale count for this half of the county has reached 76,244 bales. Included in this count are Lockney Coop, South Plains, Sterley, Lockney Gin, D&J Gin, Evans, Barwise, Crume, Marble Bros.,

and Providence gins. This count has already surpassed last year's total by more than half as last year's total bale count reached only 32,839. Even though farmers have produced more cotton than last year, this year's prices are considerably lower than they were last year and the farmers are experiencing some difficulty in

selling their crops. The 1983 cotton prices ranged from about 62 to 65 cents per pound. In December of 1984 this paper reported that prices were around 50 cents per pound, and they have dropped again to around 43 to 44 cents per pound.

This year's cotton crop held great promise for farmers until they tried to sell it. With prices so low, many area farmers could have problems with just paying their expenses that went into this crop.

The weather, for the most part, cooperated with farmers during the growing season in that much of the rain came when needed and the cotton crop promised to have the best yields in a couple of years. When farmers began to harvest their crops, the wet, freezing moisture came. Many farmers were kept out of the fields for one to two weeks at one time, waiting for the ground and cotton to dry enough to harvest it. When the cotton harvest resumed, farmers found much of their cotton had strung out of the bolls onto the ground. This cut down on the yield

and the quality of the cotton, making it difficult to get a good price for the crop.

If the weather will remain dry for another week to ten days, all of the remaining cotton will be harvested. All but one of the gins are expecting to complete their ginning season by the first week of February.

Most striking on city streets, along country roads and in Vietnamese homes is the visual evidence of economic decline and austerity in this vibrant, reasonably prosperous country. Lack of foreign exchange to buy petroleum and spare parts has cleared away Saigon's traffic jams. The noisy streets where
