ends up in the wastebasket, at least at this newspaper. And it is not only the politicians who bombard us with gratis material. The other day we even received a long release from Sears, letting us know (and hopefully letting the public know) that they were about to embark upon a major promotional effort through the medium of television, for goodness sake. I suppose that would be valuable information for our citizens who own television stations, which few do.

But not all of it falls in the unwanted category. Occasionally we receive some good stuff. An example is the material we get from the office of the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts, Mr. Bob Bullock. Invariably it is interesting and informative, devoid of the self-serving tripe that marks most of the rest from the state capitol.

We are in receipt now of Mr. Bullock's "Fiscal Notes" put out by his Research and Management Division. From it we learn that the mail order business is booming nationwide, with Texas accounting for 6.6 percent of national mail order purchases.

The question naturally arises. Why the popularity of mail order sales? The answer is very simple. It is a matter of prices. And why are the mail order houses able to offer such comparatively good prices? Again the answer is simple. They pay no sales tax to the state, they pay no sales tax to the cities, they pay no property taxes to help support the schools and the streets, they have no local work force, they plow nothing back into the community, they are not hit periodically by community "drives" for worthy causes, they are not called on to support community sharing efforts. In point of fact, they are free loaders, draining every small community in America and enriching the bank accounts of merchandisers in Chicago, Atlanta, New York, you name it.

Bullock's office points out that mail order sales have grown 10 percent annually for the past five years and are expected to hit \$50 Billion (that's \$50 Billion, gentle reader) by the end of this year. If you want to get out your little pocket calculator you can determine just how much of a "saving" they are making in sales taxes alone, not to mention all the other items we outlined above.

How did we get in this mess? Back in 1967 a liberal Supreme Court ruled that states could not collect sales taxes on mail order sales, saying this would be contrary to the "commerce clause" of the Constitution. In so doing, the Court stretched the constitution to cover its own social views, just as it did to cover its views of race, education, and a host of other issues. Quite naturally the mail order business began to boom, freed as it was from another of the burdens that local merchants face. **Continued On Page 2**

For the second year in a row the Lockney Longhorns have retained the Floyd County Championship trophy by defeating the Floydada Whirlwinds. The final score of the game was Lockney 6, Floydada 0.

Lockney's only score came on their second possession of the game. Lockney took the opening kickoff with the wind at their backs. They were unable to convert for the needed first down and punted to the Winds. The Winds took the ball and fumbled and Lockney recovered on the Floydada 32 yard line. On the first down play Matt Mitchell ran the dive play and garnered 13 yards. The next play was a Cates keeper for 7 yards. Allen Stallings ran the sweep play for 6 yards and Cates took another keeper for 4 yards on the next play. With just three yards to score, the ball was handed off to Tony Banda who ran the sweep for the needed yardage and Lockney was on the board. The Banda extra point attempt failed but Lockney had scored the needed points to win the game.

The second quarter went much as the first without any scoring. On the first play of the second quarter Johnny Torrez carried the ball for a Lockney first down on the Winds 41 yard line, however after three more plays Lockney was unable to convert for the first down and punted back to the Winds.

Floydada began a 10 play drive on their own 26 yard line. They were unable to make the first down, even after a penalty was accessed to the Horns and punted back to Lockney. Four plays later Lockney returned the ball to the opponents.

Floydada took the ball on the Lockney 35 yard line, and was accessed a penalty and on a first and 15 yard play Lockney quarterback Steven Cates, playing safety on defense, intercepted a pass and Lockney took possession on their own 15 yard line.

The next Lockney drive saw some excellent field work by the offense as

Floydada took the ball on their own 23 0 yard line and were only able to move it back out to their own 31 before returning the ball to the Horns. Lockney had only two plays before the half.

The third and fourth quarters of the game were marked with fumbles. Twice Floydada fumbled and Lockney would recover and then Lockney would move the ball two or three plays and fumble back to the opponents.

Penalities were also heavy in the game. There were a total of 12 penalties for 140 yards lost in the ball game.

Coach Bob Purser commented, "Losing the ball was a big problem for us. We were inside the 20 yard line six times and lost the ball. We played an exceptionally hard game but the penalties and fumbles really hurt us.'

"Floydada also played a very hard ball game, just about as hard a game as I have ever seen them play. If they continue to play this hard they deserve to win some of their games this year".

The Horns of the Week for the Floydada game include offensive lineman George Basaldua, offensive back Tony Banda, defensive lineman Lupe Basaldua, defensive back Johnny Torrez, and special teams player Lupe Basaldua, who garnered the two big hits in the game. The Horns of the Week are both Lupe and George Basaldua.

first at play day



School board discusses enrollment figures

The Lockney Independent School Board of Directors met for their regular monthly meeting on Monday, September 16 and the board and the building principals discussed, among other things, the enrollment and ethnic breakdown at each of the three schools. In elementary school there are a total of 367 students enrolled. Of that

number 37% are Anglo, 58% are Mexican-American, and 5% are black. Enrollment at the elementary school is up somewhat from the same time the past two years. In September, 1984 there were 353 enrolled and in September 1983 there were 351 enrolled at the grade school.

Junior high is showing a four student loss from this same time last year when there were 144 enrolled and for 1985

there are 140 in school. The breakdown for the junior high includes 41% Anglo, 55% Mexican-American, and 4% black students enrolled in the junior high school.

Lockney High School is also showing a slight drop in enrollment for 1985. There are presently 193 students enrolled and for September 1984 the school had 210 enrolled. Of those presently enrolled 37% are Anglo, 58% are Mexican-American, and 5% are black. In other action the board approved a


school-wide discipline plan. This plan is written to encompass all forms of discipline procedures for all students enrolled in the Lockney school system. Parents of students in high school and junior high were sent copies of the plan and asked to send a signed sheet back to school with their children. House Bill 72 requires that a school wide plan be developed.

The board also approved membership in both the South Plains Association of School Boards and the Texas Association of Community Schools. Both of these organizations held meetings throughout the year which superintendent W.H. Hallmark says are very helpful to him and the Lockney school system. He commented that "The Texas Association of Community Schools is especially helpful as they work for the good of the smaller community schools like Lockney."

The board has also approved the purchase of a new 47 passenger school







It has been the Soviet military that has felt the sweep of Communist Party Chief Mikhail Gorbachev's "new broom." The results could affect both the Kremlin's defense strategy and its relations with President Reagan.

The most important move in a wide ranging military shake up was the July appointment of Marshal Nikolai Ogazkov as First Deputy Minister and comander of Warsaw Pact forces. Ogazkov, 67, had been mysteriously dismissed last fall as chief of the Soviet general staff.

In another key change Gen. Alexey Lizichev, 57, replaced Gen. Alexey Yepishev, a 77 year old ideological hard liner as chief political commissar of the armed forces. Diplomats in Moscow

said the high command shake up involves at least three other top commanders, including the chief of the strategic rocket forces.

Ogarkov is best known in the West for publicly defending the shooting down of a South Korean airliner over Sakhalin Island in 1983. Bringing Ogarkov back from near oblivion gives Gorbachev another sophisticated and competant ally in the Kremlin hierarchy. The move reaffirmed Gorbachev's grip on the levers of power as well as his willingness to promote the people he needs, to wake up a sluggish system.

Analysts predict that Ogarkov will help Gorbachev prepare some strong challenges for President Reagan at their November meeting.

What to do? Frankly, I believe it will be difficult to do much of anything. But that does not mean we ought not to try. The National Direct Marketing Association is a very powerful lobby with Congress. So is the nationwide lobby of direct mailers. The two industries, combined with the mutual interests of political fund raising efforts, conducted by direct mailers, adds another element working against any effort to relieve the situation.

But there is hope. Bullock is at least one state official who is aware of the problem, and sympathetic to Texas taxpayers. Let us hope that the retail merchants of this state support and encourage him in his efforts by leaning on other state officials to help.
