## 1984-85 school district performance discussed

One of the new mandates set forth by House Bill 72 is that each school district in the state of Texas compose an annual report on the school's performance for the year. The performance report for the 1984-85 school year in Lockney was discussed at the monthly board meeting on November 14.

The report discusses several areas in which the school operates. These areas include general information on student performance, program offering, staff, facilities, financial conditions, attendance, dropouts, educational achievement and several others.

In this article we will discuss the basic information in the report. Those who wish to inspect the full report may do so in the superintendent's office during regular office hours.

#### **Student Performance**


In the past five years the Lockney I.S.D. set goals to improve the math and reading skills of students. To meet this goal a system wide program of objectives was put into place. Those objectives included having a minimum of 50% students, they still met the 50% objective.

To date the high school students have not achieved the 50% mastery in reading. Through the addition of essential elements and the tutorial program offered in high school, administrators are confident that these students will master the basic reading skills.

In the area of math, the elementary school students testing shows that 88% of the students are working at or above grade levels. TEAMS Test results show that 98% of all the objectives on the test were mastered by the students in grade one through five.

In grades six through eight, test results show that 65% of the students are working at or above grade levels in math. In grades nine through 12 the tests show that 54% of the students are at or above grade levels.

Student performance in the elementary school has shown a marked improvement since the departmentalization began in the 1982-83 school year. This program began with grades three four and five, and in 1983-84 the second grade was also departmentalized. The two major programs to which much of the improvement in students performance may be attributed are the Pegesus-Pace reading program and the Brevard Math program. Through these programs students are grouped according to their progress in each subject.

## 1985 Lockney Longhorns fall short of second title

An opportunistic band of Hale Center Owls, taking full advantage of every break which came its way, short circuited the Longhorns' playoff aspirations Saturday night in Plainview's Bulldog Stadium by a 36-12 count.

After two ties in less than a year, experts figured the second consecutive bi-district matchup between the Longborns and the Owls would again be close. The two squads battled to a 6-6 deadlock in the '84 bi-district encounter - won by Lockney with a 3-1 penetration advantage - and fought to a scoreless draw on Sept. 27.

Saturday's match, however, was one of those nights when Lady Luck happened to be stationed on Hale Center's side of the field.

Sparring for position, neither eleven was able to rack up a first down in the early going until Joe Torrez' 29 yard punt was fielded by Ronald Phillips. He handed to Michael Peggram on a crossing pattern, and the shifty senior never turned off the jets until he had raced 60 yards down the west sideline to send the Owls in front 6-0 with 8:19 still to play in quarter number one. Keith Roden dropped quarterback Jamie Garibay's pass on a two point attempt. This staked the District 3-AA runner-up to a lead before it had racked up a first down.

#### **Owls Strike Quickly**

With Dame Fortune smiling at the blue clad Owls, they struck for 16 points in two minutes and 55 seconds midway through the second quarter to stun the Angry Red. Both touchdowns were set up by fumble recoveries.

Mitch McBeth capped a 37 yard, nine play drive from 2 yards out to run the count to 12-0 with 7:13 remaining in the second period. The effort was started with a fumble recovery at the Lockney 37. Peggram took a pitch from Garibay and swept right end for two bonus points.

John Torrez returned the ensuing kick to the 'Horn 35, but on the first snap Phillips pounced on the loose pighide to hand the Owls another golden opportunity at the Lockney 35.

The Angry Red defensive unit allowed a single yard in two plays before Roden hauled in a Garibay aerial for 18 steps and a first at the 16. On fourth-and-one from the 7, Garibay

dialed his own number and kept around left end to run the jubilant Owls' edge to 20-0. Tall Chris Cannon pulled in a Garibay pass for the bonus points as the scoreboard showed a 22-0 Hale Center advantage with 4:18 remaining before the bands performed.

Joe Torrez' interception in the end zone helped the Longhorns turn back another Owl bid with only 22 seconds left in the second period. Hale Center had driven from its 8 to the 'Horn 5 before Torrez' timely interception.

Lockney's sturdy defense opened the second half as it had closed out the first, by bending but not breaking.

Returning Ben Schuster's third quarter kickoff from the 6 to its 31, the Owls again cranked up their offensive machine - spearheaded by the running trio of Peggram, McBeth and Phillips and aerials from Garibay to Roden - Hale Center put together four first downs and advanced to the Lockney 14. Peggram was slammed for a yard loss before George Basaldua controlled a Peggram fumble at the 15.

Seven snaps later, Lupe Basaldua picked off another Owl fumble at midfield. Three downs later, the Longhorns returned the favor and Hale Center recovered at its 43.

Late in the third quarter, John Torrez gathered in a 33 yard Steven Cates pass and dashed to the enemy 36. A dropped pass on fourth down cut short the effort.

Rusty Teeter was on the receiving end of a 16 yard pass from Cates as the final period opened. But on the next snap Peggram intercepted a Longhorn aerial at the LL 44.

#### **Ball Bounces Owls' Way**

The Owls advanced for three first downs, the last at the 51/2. Again, the Angry Red defense rose to the occasion and allowed a single yard in four downs to take possession just inside their 5.

Cates was sacked by a hard rush at the 2 and then was held to no gain. Lady Luck once more smiled on the Cwls as Peggram came up with a loose ball at the Longhorn 1. His reward was an opportunity to score, and the hard running senior did just on the next play to stake the Owls to a 28-0 edge. Phillips circled left end to make it 30-0 with 6:19 remaining.

The Angry Red's mood was just what the name implies. Javier Bernal accept-

ed McBeth's kick at the 6 and ran to near his own 30, where he was apparently penned in by blue shirts. But the quick 130 pound sophomore broke free, moved to the west sideline and raced to the Owl 6 before being downed. Cates found a hole in the left side of his line and stepped off 6 yards to paydirt as the Lockney fans roared their approval. Cates pass attempt for two extra points was knocked down in the end zone.

Striking quickly, as their opponents had in the second quarter, the Longhorns finally received a break as Schuster fell on a fumble at the Lockney 49... just three plays after the first 'Horn touchdown.

John Torrez made a nifty catch of a Cates pass as he was falling out of bounds for a 26 yard gainer. Hard charging Matt Mitchell powered his way for 5 steps to the Owl 20. Bernal leaped between two defenders to haul in a touchdown strike from Cates for another Lockney six-pointer with 4:13 remaining. Cates was stopped about the 1 on an attempt to garner two more points.

Joe Torrez' on-side kick attempt was covered by Hale Center at the Lockney 49. The relentless Owls marched the 49 yards in eight plays — four first downs - for their final TD. A 'Horn personal foul moved the ball to the 8 and Phillips barreled across on the next play. Torrez stopped Phillips on the extra points run, but Hale Center's lead had gone to 36-12 with 61 seconds remaining.

Battling back from adversity, as they have all season, the Angry Red was not ready to hoist the white flag. Jimmy Ballejo returned Victor Herrera's kick from the 16 to the 44. Tony Banda relled off 6 yards before Monty Means caught a Cates pass for 13 yards to the enemy 37. Battling both the clock and Hale Center, Bernal grabbed another Cates aerial. But Dame Fortune wouldn't allow the 'Horns another break as the ball popped from Bernal's arms as he tried for extra yardage at the 16 and Hale Center recovered.

Hale Center ran out the clock on the next snap.

The Longhorns threatened to grab the lead following the initial Hale Center TD. With Bernal, Mitchell, Cates and Banda sharing rushing duties, the white shirts methodically marched from their 45, following Bernal's kick return, to the Owl six inch line on 13 snaps. They picked up four first downs along the way. Banda's 9 yard thrust set his team up at the enemy 9. Banda was then held to no gain before reaching the 2 yard line. Cates kept for 1 and Banda was halted just shy of the double stripe on fourth down.

David Sutterfield's interception at the Owl 33 handed the 'Horns another chance. Losses of 7 steps and an incomplete pass forced a Joe Torrez punt, which rolled to the 8. **Standing Tall** 

Although the Longhorns failed to advance to area level of the playoffs as they did in '84, Coach Bob Purser's troops can stand proud. During a campaign billed as a "rebuilding year" following heavy graduation losses last spring, the Angry Red reached the playoffs for the second consecutive campaign. Before the '84 season, no Lockney team had reached the playoffs in 10 seasons.

The youthful gridders gained experience in the early going, posting a 1-3-1 record against rugged non-conference foes — including three playoff teams in Tulia, Hale Center and Abernathy. They notched a record of four victories and one tie against District 4-AA rivals. Perhaps their proudest moment came Oct. 25 when they battled Crosbyton to a 14-14 tie, but earned the right to advance into the playoffs as the league's number one team by virtue of a 4-3 advantage on penetrations.

They close out the campaign with a 5-4-2 record.

Only 10 members of the 26 man varsity during the regular season were seniors. These lads, who concluded their prep football careers Saturday night in Plainview were (listed numerically by jersey number): David Sutterfield, Monty Means, Chris Rodriguez, Tony Banda, Ronnie Ford, George Basaldua, David DeLeon, Trent Gant, Randy Race and John Torrez.

The iron rule of President Ferdinand Marcos is under growing pressure, in the Philippines. Washington is moving openly to preserve its most precious military asset in the Pacific.

In the past, the administration has remained publicly calm about Marcos' prospects. However, it dropped the facade when President Reagan in mid-October sent a personal envoy, Senator Paul Laxalt (R-Nev.) to give Marcos a warning that his government was in danger of being overthrown.

The stakes for the U.S. are high. Most important is the security of Clark Air Base and Subic Bay Naval Base, the two biggest U.S. military installations outside the mainland. Both represent U.S. strategic power, nuclear and non-nuclear, in the western Pacific. They are a counter-weight to the Soviet presence in Vietnam and essential to the peace of mind of American friends throughout a vast region. Marcos' popularity has been up and down for years. The most dangerous threat to Marcos comes from the New People's Army, a Communist guerrilla organization attracting more' and more peasants. The NPA is growing steadily in ability as well as strength, and its bold forays now reach into the capital,

Manila. Bishop Antonio Fortich in Negros province says that as many as 400,000 people in his region have been displaced by the decline of the monopolized sugar industry. Too, Washington has repeatedly urged Marcos to break up sugar and coconut monopolies run by friends. In June the Reagan administration withheld 40 million dollars in food aid until Marcos agreed to end the state-run monopoly on wheat and flour imports.

If the Marcos government should fall, the U.S. must decide how far it is prepared to go to retain its strategic position in the Philippines.



## School district performance...

#### **Continued From Page 1**

In junior high the course offerings meet state requirements and contained in the junior high building are a complete computer lab for the computer literacy classes as well as for math and migrant classes. Students' are also offered homemaking and art in junior high.

The high school offers 42 different courses. If students are interested in correspondence classes, they are offered through Texas Tech in Lubbock. High school students also have access to computer classes and will be offered a foreign language when the necessary teacher can be found. Each school facility is also furnished with a complete library facility.

#### Extra-Curricular Student Activities The Lockney I.S.D. offers several

extra-curricular activities for students. The junior high students have the opportunity to participate in band, football, basketball, track and they also have a Gifted and Talented Program. Junior high students in the athletic program have won district competitions in the past. The Gifted and Talented Program students have participated in State competition as a team for the past

two years in the problem solving contest. In high school, students may choose from band, football, basketball, track and UIL Literary events for extra-curricular activities. The band is consistently bringing home awards for their efforts, and the football team has been district champions for the past two years. Also the cross country teams have received recognition for their efforts in the past three years including a State championship this year.

Also offered in high school are the vocational agriculture and homemaking programs.

#### Staff

The staff of the Lockney Independent School District includes 40 teachers with bachelor degrees and 14 with masters degrees. All four of the administrators have masters degrees to their credit.

The teaching staff has a combined total of 643 years of experience with those ranging from one year of experience to 43 years of experience.

#### Facilities

The Lockney Independent School District consists of two major sights. The elementary school is located on West Eighth Street. The high school, students. Over the past two years the building has had a complete facelift. A new roof was installed, the outside of the building was cleaned and repaired and a large portion of the windows have been enclosed. Classroom renovation of the high school is planned for this year.

The junior high facility was completed in 1957 and consists of classrooms, a gym, band hall and lunchroom, which is no longer in use. Like the high school the building has had a new facelift in the past two years. A new roof was installed, the outside was cleaned, and windows were closed in. Again upgrading the classrooms is planned for this year.

In each of the building facilities, central heating and cooling are used.

In order to keep the best possible facilities for students, the school board has approved expenditures from \$40,000 to \$150,000 each summer for a major improvement on the educational buildings.

#### **Financial Condition**

The Lockney school system is in very sound financial condition. Over the past three years State aide has increased and the bonded indebtedness of the school has been paid off.

The school board operates under the concensus that if possible at least two months operating expenses be kept in reserve at all times. Over the past three years the school has ended the year with a surplus balance. In 1982-83 the surplus was \$492,000 in 1983-84 it was \$498,000. This year the surplus was \$729,000, which was due to the increase in State aide.

The surplus amounts, over and above the two months operating expenses kept in reserve, are used each summer for renovations to the facilities, staff pay increases, and career ladder moves.

Due to the careful planning of the board, the school system has only once had to borrow money, about four years ago, to start the school year.

#### **Other Information**

Other miscellaneous information contained in the report include the fact that there are now 54 teachers on the career ladder. Of the 54 teachers, 15 women are on level two of the ladder, as are 15 men.

Attendance ratios for the past year are also included. Elementary school had an attendance ratio of 96.75%, junior high a ratio of 97%, and high
