Tradition comes to an end

Last Texas cannery closes with auction

By Juanita Stepp

A largely sentimental crowd gathered in Lockney for the auction marking the final closure of the last operated, public used cannery in the state of Texas. Nearly 100 people vied for the remaining equipment and the cannery building during the sale, held Saturday, December 7. Gregg and Fortenberry Auction Services raised a total of \$2,829.50 for the county auction.

Floyd County Judge Choise Smith stated, "Many of the bidders were women and a lot of older people were there. I guess it was kind of a sentimental thing for a lot of the people attending. They were sorry to see it

The building was purchased by Harley Workman of Lockney for \$210.00. The legality of selling the lots

was in question at the time of the sale, so the lots were not sold. A separate proceeding will be held to dispose of the lots. County Auditor Bobby Hamilton has been appointed special commissioner to handle the sale of the lots.

Precinct 2 Commissioner Bob Jarrett cited the unavailability of cans and the lack of goods to can, along with the high costs, as the primary reason for closing the cannery, which began operating more than 50 years ago. "It has cost the county taxpayers nearly 50 cents a can for every can processed this year," stated Jarrett. "This is in addition to the 25 cents per can the user paid. It is just not good common sense to spend that kind of money to subsidize the operation.

The 1985 pheasant season will open this Saturday morning with the annual Pheasant Hunter's Breakfast at the Trinity Lutheran Church in the Provi-

dence Community. The breakfast will begin at about 5:45 a.m. and will be held in the fellowship hall of the church. This year, as in past years, the church members will have a wide range of foods including eggs, biscuits, gravy, toast, coffee, ham, sausage, and milk. Cost of the breakfast is \$4.00 which is the same as last year.

Pheasant season to open Saturday, December 14

Pheasant season for Floyd County opens Saturday, December 14 and will continue through December 29. The bag limit this year has changed and limits include two cocks per day and a total of four in the hunter's possession.

Other bird seasons opening at the present time include duck, goose, sandhill crane, and quail.

Duck season opened on November 9 and will continue through January 12, 1986. Bag limits on ducks are reached when a specific total of points on ducks shot has been reached.

Goose season opened in Floyd County on October 29 and will remain open until January 19, 1986. Bag limits on geese include five geese, not to include more than two Canada, black brant, or white fronted geese in the aggregate. Possession limit is twice the daily

Sandhill crane season opened on November 30 and will continue through February 9, 1986. Daily limit on cranes is three and possession should not

Quail season has been open since November 2 and will continue through

February 23. Shooting times for all the above mentioned season is from one half hour before sunrise to sunset.

The opening of pheasant season brings many people to our country who may not be familiar with this area and there are several steps that can be taken to avoid hunting accidents.

First and foremost check with landowners and make sure it is alright if you hunt on their property. Also see if the owner has given permission of others to hunt on the same property. If there will be others hunting on the same land as you, find out where they intend to hunt and avoid this area. This will prevent you or someone else from accidentally shooting at a person and not a bird. It is also a good idea to wear brightly colored clothing when bird hunting especially if you are going to be in tall grass or weeds.

Make certain that any young or unexperienced hunters are well supervised when out hunting. Above all else make sure you know where each member of your hunting party is at all times. If there are other parties hunting in the same area let them also know






