Earlier,Clements signed an executive order urging all state agencies and instiutions of higher education in Texas to
participate in the VOTE '90 drive. The main goals of VOTE ' 90 , Bayoud said, are to register new voters and increase turnout. Of the state's currently estimated 12.4 million eligible voters,
