Accidental gunshot fatal to

Two weeks before his graduation was killed at his home by of Lockney discharge of a 12 gauge shotgun. Edwards was known throughout the Lock ney community for his love of art, his
pleasant smile his polite denean pleasant smile, his polite demeanor and hard work.
According to police, the accident occurred at approximately 11 p.m. Tuesday, May 15, at the Edwards home, 616 S. Main. Kelly, while studying his
school lessons, was visiting with two of his fellow schoolmates. One of the friends noticed a 12 gauge shotgun under the bed and pulled it out, asking Edwards if it was loaded.
Kelly replied that it was not loaded ook the gun from his friend and apparently hit the trigger with his thumb while showing the weapon. The weapon discharged striking Kelly in the face.
Kelly's mother, Linda Edwards was asleep in her room at the time of the accident. His father, Jerry Edwards, who is a Sergeant with the Lockney Police Department, was on duty at the me and not at home. Kelly's friends,
