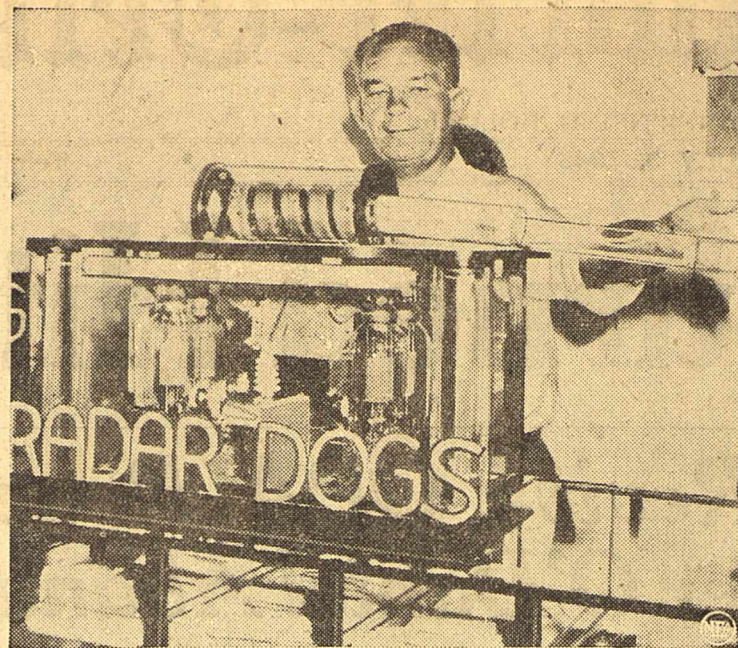

 State, North Southwest Andrews County discovery for production from the Tubb-Permian, at about 7,127 feet to about 7,270 feet, was drilling ahead below 8,210 feet, in a lime, thought to be Wolfcamp-Permian.

A 70-minute drillstem test was taken at 8,155-8,210 feet. There was a blow of air for 14 minutes, and it then died. Recovery was 250 feet of drilling mud, with a slight trace of oil and gas.

Harris Investigating
 Humble No. 1 Harris, Southwest a total depth of 8,406 feet, in the Sterling County prospect was on Ellenburger, entered at about 7,955 feet, on an elevation of 2,350 feet, and was taking a drillstem test. Previous tests had shown slight signs of oil and gas and considerable sulphur water.

Humble No. 1-B Federal-Leonard, north flanker to the discovery for Ellenburger production in the Dublin field, in extreme Southeast Lea County, New Mexico, bottomed out at 12,535 feet, in Ellenburger, on which no top has been reported. That formation tested for water. Operator is to plug back to about 7,000 feet and test slight shows of oil and gas in several streaks, from that point, upward in the hole.
 Stanolind Oil & Gas Company No. 1 Kayser, Central Ector County wildcat, had reached 12,337 feet in lime and chert, of the lower Devonian, and was going ahead slowly.
