**CSOC Is To Drill—**

Gas showed at the surface in five minutes. Oil started flowing in 39 minutes. In five hours and 45 minutes of flowing to tanks the drill pipe flowed 254 barrels of 39.8 gravity oil—for an average hourly production of 42.4 barrels. Gas-oil ratio was 1.310-1.  
Operator had cemented 7-inch casing at 8,470 feet with 800 sacks. Unofficial sources indicate that the project may be completed from the Silurian—rather than be drilled ahead to the Ellenburger, as some reports had it scheduled to do.  
Kaysar Makes Some Oil  
Etanolind No. 1 Kaysar, 660 feet from south and west lines of section 34, block 43, TP survey, T-2-S, and a Central Ector County wildcat, swabbed out 423 barrels of oil in 60 hours—of which 134 barrels was load oil, and the remaining 289 barrels was new oil. That was at the rate of 4.8 barrels of new oil per hour, for the time of the test. The project was shuttin to pressure up, at last report.  
The production is coming from perforated zones at 8,405-8,525 feet, and at 8,535-65 feet, which had been treated with 5,000 gallons of acid.

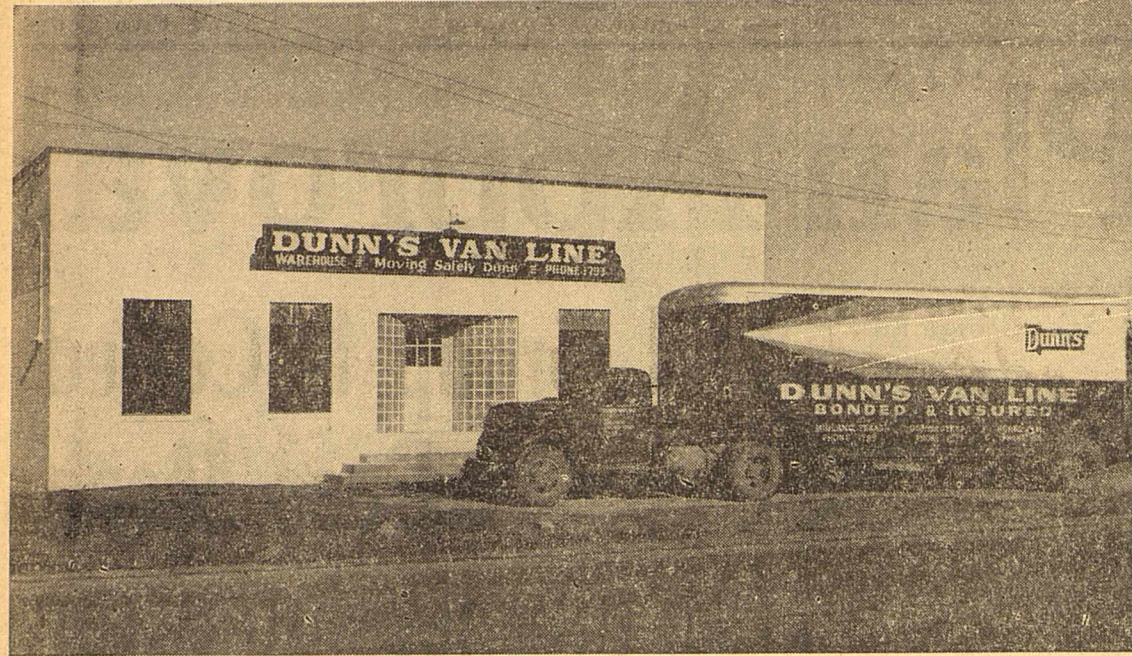
**Six Dow Chemical Unions Are Without Contracts**

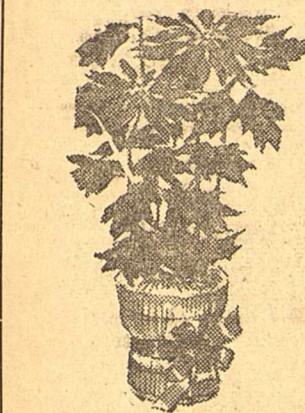

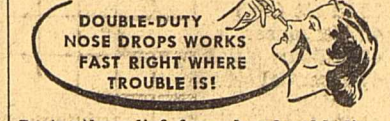
