Russian Lullaby
A threadbare truism has it that people are pretty
much the same the world over．If that is so，we＇d like to
try out the State Department＇s first hour－long broadcast
to Russia on America listeners and have Hooper or
Crossley rate their reactions．
Our guess is，after reading a printed English trans－
lation of the lead－off program，that few Americans would
have been listening at the finish．And we can well im－－
agine a similar reaction in Russia－unless some pretty
dull English copy comes out sparkling and dramatic in
the Russian language．
This much is certain．A few programs like the first
one should counteract the frequent statements by Rus－
sian writers that Americans are a jazz－mad，movie－mad，
money－mad tribe．The sprightliest vision part of the
State Department＇s radio premiere－aside from record－
ings of＂Turkey in the Straw＂and＂Night and Day＂－
was a discourse on pyribenzamine，the new synthetic
chemical treatment for hay fever and similar allergies．
It may have been a cold night in Russia，and the hay
fever season may have been seven months away，but ihey
got the detailed，polysyllabic works on pyribenzamine．
At the end the listeners were told that＂at the present
time pyribenzamine is being produced in limited quanti－
ties and is released only on demand by a physician＂．
