tives surely did not improve the Taft-Iartley Bill.
But there are two things that could be done, even if
the law were as bad as its opponents say it is; even if
there were not one good thing about tit, as Truman thinks;
even if not only Taft and Hartley but the majority of both
parties who voted for their bill were maliciously bent on
destroying organized labor in America.
The constitutionality of the law's provisions could be
tested in the courts. If any or all of the provisions were
found to deprive a citizen or group of citizens of their
constitutional rights, the Supreme Court could overrule
the act of Congress.

House of Representatives and one-third of the Senate, If
the Taft-Hartley Act was a denial of the popular will, the
