

# **Congress says DOE** won't dump in Texas

What started just over six years ago with a handfull of people forming an organization called STAND (Serious Texans Against Nuclear Dumping) grew into a network of concerned citizens and dedicated organizations who have made their voice heard in Washington.

Late Monday night the budget reconciliation bill passed the House and the Senate, and tied to that bill was a proposal which virtually guarantees that a proposed high level nuclear waste repository will not be built in the Texas Panhandle.

The bill awaits the President's signature, and legislators are hopeful that he will sign the bill before Christmas.

The proposal on the nuclear waste repository, the culmination of a week of intense negotiations, calls for the Department of Energy (DOE) to characterize Yucca Mountain, Nevada, only, and states that DOE will cease all work at the Deaf Smith and Hanford sites (except for reclamation) within 90 days of enactment.

House and Senate negotiaters

seemed to have reached an impasse at mid-week last week, but Speaker of the House Jim Wright intervened and got the ball rolling again.

One point of contention on the proposal was the allowance for a Monitored Retrieveable Storage site. The original proposal by the House called for no authorization for an MRS site.

The final proposal stated that an MRS site would be established only when construction begins on a permanent repository. The proposal further stipulates that if the repository license is revoked or repository construction ceases, MRS authorization also ceases.

Delbert Devin, consultant to the Castro, Parmer and Swisher Counties Repository Assessment Commission, said that the passage of this proposal reaffirms ones faith in our democratic system of government. It proves, Devin said, that when one little person gets together with a lot of other little people they can still make a difference.

"I believe this thing needs to be done right, and it still isn't being done right," Devin said.

The new proposal does provide, though, for the site selection to be "done right." One provision of the proposal states that if Yucca Mountain proves unsuitable, DOE has to cease work and report back to Congress.

The proposal also provides for research and developement of dry cask storage and subseabed storage, a feature which pleased Devin.

Devin said the Nuclear Waste Task Force will continue to fight against the unsafe disposal of nuclear waste, noting that the focus of their efforts will probably turn to the transportation of waste across the state's highways such as I-40.

## **County is designated** as redevelopement area



The Commissioners voted to make their \$500 monthly payment for the ambulance service to a separate ambulance account set up by the three entities involved, i.e., the County Commissioners, the City Board of Aldermen and the Hospital Board. The Commissioners stipulated that the signatures of the County Judge, the Mayor and the Chairman of the Hospital Board should be required for the release of any funds from that account.

## DISD looks at 1987 **TEAMS** tests results school or are potential dropouts.

Results from the October TEAMS tests taken by juniors at Dimmitt High School revealed a decrease in the percentage of students showing total mastery in both the math and language arts area of the test when compared with the 1986 results.

But the decrease in percentage could be attributed to the increase in the number of math problems that had to be answered correctly to demonstrate mastery, according to **DISD Curriculum Director Gainell** Minnick.

Minnick told the school board at its meeting last Wednesday that scores dropped statewide.

"Basically, we did all right, but there's always room for improvement," Minnick remarked. "The tests are a valuable tool to help determine what objectives might need more emphasis."

In response to recent rumors concerning Dimmitt Middle School, Supt. Robert Ryan told the board that investigations by the school principals and the police have not turned up any gang activi-

"There were some incidents of roughhousing and typical bullying, and those involved have been disciplined," Ryan said. "However, no instances of premeditated abuse have been discovered."

Board members approved the self-responsibility curriculum proposed by an appointed task force including Minnick, building principals, classroom teachers, parents and patrons. Units in the curriculum, graded for levels early childhood through 12th grade, deal with. subjects including substance abuse, child abuse, sexuality, and AIDS.

Ryan said the units will be incorporated during the second semester of this school year. He noted that the board gave approval for the Castro County Ministerial Alliance to hold a community-wide program on AIDS in the high school auditorium Jan. 17, just before the new semester starts Jan. 18.

Board members authorized Ryan

# ATVs not safe for small children

With sales of more than 2 million in 1986, an all-terrain vehicle may sound like an ideal gift this Christmas. But according to the December issue of Texas Medicine, use of the three-wheeled ATV has caused serious and fatal injuries.

All-terrain vehicles are motorized off - the - road three or four wheeled vehicles with balloon-like tires for use on sand, mud, and other surfaces. A study of ATV-

zations for trauma reported at two hospitals were due to motor vehicle accidents and that ATVs were responsible for 25 injuries, with two deaths resulting from severe head injuries, states the official journal of the Texas Medical Association. Authors Drs. Mark J. Kubala and Carl E. Shrontz, Beaumont, note that most of the patients were young white males, and only one wore a protective helmet.

The authors say design of the

an ATV. They add that the fourwheeled ATV is more stable than the three-wheeler and that nationally 74 percent of three-wheel ATV accidents started with tipping or overturning compared to 59 percent for the four-wheeled version.

"Children below the age of six years are physically too small and insufficiently coordinated to operate even the smallest ATV models,..." write the authors. They add that children ages 6 through 11 do not have adequate judgment needed to operate an ATV and that their reaction time is too slow. Poor judgement was noted in 31 percent of fatal accidents and insufficient ability in 22 percent, according to a Consumer Product Safety Commission ATV Task Force study. It also showed "that all drivers under 16 years of age had a relatively higher risk of injury on adult-sized ATVs..." The article notes taking risks, such as driving after drinking alcohol, not wearing a helmet, and excess speed dramatically increasethe chances of an accident. Thirty percent of all fatal ATV accidents were associated with use of alcohol, according to the Commission's report.




#### SPS customers to receive credit

Southwestern Public Service Company's (SPS) Texas retail customers will begin receiving in their January bills a one-time \$11.2 million fuel-cost credit. The refund was approved Thursday by the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT).

The "average" residential customer, based on monthly consumption of 600 kilowatt-hours, will receive about a \$10 credit, said Sam Hunter, SPS vice president of rates and economic research. The refund will include interest at an annual rate of 11.7 percent.

Hunter said lower costs for coal and natural gas, which are major expenses in generating electricity, and mild summer temperatures, which allowed the company to operate only its most efficient power plants, made the refund possible.



# Good adult relationships stem from strong families

#### **By DEANA SAGASER County Extension Agent**

Achieving an adult relationship with one's parents in later life may not be easy but the rewards can be worth the try.

An adult or mature relationship means accepting each other for who we are, including imperfections as well as positive traits. It means being able to give and receive help without feeling that your contribution to the relationship is diminished. Current relationships between adults and their aging parents are a product of earlier family life. In some families the parents were the authorities and continued to play this role even as children became adults. Such patterns from the past can dominate late life interactions between older parents and their adult children and prove dysfunctional. For example, being "the one in control" may put an aging parent in a position where receiving information or accepting help from an adult child is difficult

earlier roles.

Aging parents and aging children can examine how they relate to each other by asking themselves the following questions:

\* Do I accept my child (or parent) as an adult who has a right to his/her own opinions, values and lifestyles even if these differ from my own?

\* Am I judgmental of my children's (parent's) choices and decisions?

\* Do I interfere and try to control their lives?

because it is not in keeping with discussion. Rather than fighting about this or sneaking in the last word, there are several approaches that might be useful.

Try humor: "Now, for the last word . . . it's Mom!"

Try honest self - disclosure: "Mom, when you must always add one last comment I feel like my ideas don't have any merit."

Or ask for direct feedback: "Mom, did you think my last idea was a good one?"

Often such approaches can initiate the development of insight by others about their behavior. With insight a person can begin to laugh at his or her own foibles and appreciate different shortcomings in others. Adult children and aging parents can construct new relationships by understanding their past and accepting each other as people who just happen to be related.

during the upcoming holiday periods, DPS Director Leo Gossett siad.

Gossett said the Department believes as many as 42 persons will be killed on the state's streets and highways during the Christmas holidays, with another 35 losing their lives over the New Year's travel time.

"If 77 persons were to die in one incident, it would be considered a major disaster," Gossett siad. "Traffic deaths, even though they are individual occurrences, are no less tragic to the family and friends of the victim, and to us all."

The Christmas holiday period begins at 6 p.m. December 23 and continues for 102 hours until midnight December 27. The New Year's holiday period will begin at 6 p.m. December 30 and continue through midnight January 3, also 102 hours.

In 1986, 28 persons died as a result of injuries suffered in traffic accidents during a 54-hour holiday period, with another 20 dying as a result of injuries suffered during the 54-hour New Year's period.

The Department will be issuing periodic reports on the number of traffic deaths to the news media during the Christmas and New Year's periods to heighten traffic safety awareness.

The fatality estimates are prepared by the Department's Statistical Services Division.

"We base the estimates on the length of the holiday period, current fatality rates and previous fatality counts," said Jim Templeton, manager of the statistical division. "We're hopeful that Texas drivers will take additional care so these estimates will turn out to be far too high."

Colonel Gossett said all available Highway Patrol troopers will be out during the holiday periods.



traffic deaths - DWI as well as excessive speed," Gossett said.

"This is the first Christmas season during which the new drinking and driving law and the 65 mph speed limit on portions of interstate highways will be in effect," the DPS director added.

"It is a violation in Texas for a driver to drink an alcholic beverage while operating a motor vehicle," Gossett siad. "This is an important law, because some driving impairment can occur below the .10 blood alchol level that is the point of intoxication as defined by law."

# Gramm tries to put LSC back on track

Farmers face the constant risks of hail, heat, disease, and falling prices, and now, says Senator Phil Gramm, there is a new pestilence to add to the list.

Farmers are now facing ruin at the hands of federal lawsuits, paid for by the Legal Services Corporation (LSC) funded by tax dollars.

Although the LSC was originly set up by Congress to provide poor people with individual legal assis-

help with property tance settlements, divorces, adoptions, and other routine legal matters the LSC has over the years strayed from its mandate, according to Gramm. It now finances group lawsuits promoting land use planning, unionism, and other political causes, Gramm said.

Agriculture is the target of much of this litigation, Gramm said, citing that LSC-related groups have

filed lawsuits against farmers, growers and ranchers as test cases, or simply to make a point.

Many farmers have fallen to financial ruin because of frivilous suits brought by the LSC, according to Gramm. And, when farmers are forced out of business, farm workers - the very people these lawsuits are supposed to benefit -loose their jobs, Gramm said.

Not only does the Legal Services

Corporation use tax payers money to promote political and social causes through lawsuits, it also uses its federal funding to lobby government to enact the agenda of social and political activists, Gramm said.

Gramm is offering an amendment to reform the operation of the LSC in the hopes of getting the agency back to what it was originally intended to do: giving individual poor people the legal assistance they would otherwise be unable to afford.

The proposed ammendment will require the LSC money be used only for the direct delivery of services to the poor and any resulting administrative expenses. The ammendment would eliminate funding for the support centers, and thus court cases, that are promoting a political agenda at the taxpayers' expense, Gramm said.

Carl King of the Texas Corn

Growers Association said the TCGA has long fought the Texas Rural Legal Aid and its illegal practices. The intent of Congress, King said, has always been to provide legal representation to the poor, not to use our tax dollars for unjustified lawsuits against us.

King urged people to contact their congressman and other legislators in support of the ammendment Gramm is proposing.

## **Corn growers have new voice in Capitol**

There are two new organizations in Washington, D. C., both founded by the Texas Corn Growers Association, the intent of which is to provide grassroots commodity representation in Washington to help convince lawmakers that fair prices and supply management are necessary to return prosperity to rural America, says TCGA President Carl King.

The first organization, the American Corn Growers Association, is currently canvassing for membership. King said they have mailed

20,000 letters to corn producers in 42 states seeking their membership in the ACGA. The letters will go out in Texas by Jan. 1, 1988.

"Your charter membership will place you on the ground floor of a national commodity group whose only business is to keep you in business;" King said, "a national commodity group who will fight for a fair return to America's farmers, and who feels that low corn prices are the problem instead of a solution."

The second organization is the American Corn Growers Foundation, a tax-free entity which will be able to receive tax-free donations from corporations and foundations.


These donations will go to promote the use of Ethanol on a national scale and to push for a supply management farm system for corn, King said.

King said the TCGA had no quarrel with the already existing National Corn Growers Association on matters of research and development and extended useage of corn.

"Our differences with NCGA are on their farm policy," King said. "Lowering the loan level on corn to be competitive in world markets has already proved a failure."

King hopes there will be a press conference to announce the two organizations in early February. They will also be discussed at the upcoming annual meeting of the TCGA tentatively slated in late February.

King said all new memberships in the ACGA will be mailed to the Washington office at P. O. Box 18157, Washington, D. C., 20036. Membership in ACGA is \$25 per year, the same membership fee as that for TCGA.

## Wayward whooping crane sighted in Amarillo vicinity

Hunters in Randall County and surrounding areas have been alerted to watch for a juvenile whooping crane sighted about 15 miles southeast of Amarillo.

Bruce Thompson, endangered species program leader for the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, said the bird has been confirmed as a juvenile whooper which has been feeding by itself on several playa lakes in the Amarillo area. Several flocks of sandhill canes are also in the area used by the whopper.

The whooping crane is an endan-

state and federal law. The whoopers reached a dismal low of only 16 birds in 1941, but they have made a slow comeback since then and currently number abbut 130 birds in the flock that migrates between Canada and Texas. The area around Amarillo cur-

rently is open to waterfowl hunting and will open for sandhill crane hunting on Nov. 28. "A hunting season closure, which would be permitted under the federal endangered species act and state law, is not being considered at this time

gered species protected by both because the bird has confined its movements entirely to a closely controlled area of private land with limited access and low hunting pressure," Thompson said. "Local landowners have been very protective of the bird, and other persons with access to the property are being advised of its presence."

> Due to the limited private access to the land and the possibility of disturbing the bird, the general public is asked to refrain from attempting to see the bird, Thompson said.

> The large white bird with black wing tips still has some rusty red juvenile feathers on its head, neck and tail. The whooper was banded as a chick at Wood Buffalo National Park in Canada this summer with yellow and blue bands on its left leg and a yellow and black band on the other.

## Kings go abroad to push for local Azodrin use

Carl and Frances King have just returned from a brief tour of England and Scotland, courtesy of the Dupont Chemical Corporation.

King, president of Texas Corn Growers Association, was on the trip to discuss the use of Azodrin for spider mites on corn.

Azodrin, produced by Dupont, is a pesticide which has become very vital to corn farmers in West Texas in battling Banks Grass mites and corn borers, King said. Azodrin does not currently hold a permanent label for use on corn. King said that Dupont still has paperwork to do, but, hopefully, after Jan. 1, 1988, TCGA will be ready to go to the Environmental Protection Agency and legislators in Washington, D. C. to bring about the Section 3 (permanent label) on Azodring for corn. "Our job," said King, "is to convince EPA that enough monitoring studies have been done in the last 10 years."

The delays in getting the permanent label have been caused primarily by environmentalists, King said.

Azodrin is already cleared for cotton, peanuts and sugar cane.

King said the trip to England and Scotland was most enjoyable. While in Edinburgh, Scotland, they saw York Minster, a magnificent church which has been there since 1350. Inside they saw a memorial to US Air Force flyers who died in World War II, King said.

## **Texas Christmas trees abundant**

Growers in the Lone Star state will market more than 500,000 Texas-grown Christmas trees this season, says Jim Chandler, a forester with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service, The Texas A&M University System.

In the early 1970's, Extension forestry specialists conducted demonstrations in East Texas to select best adapted trees and study cultural practices.

"Today, about 20 years later, the estimated value of the crop to Texas producers is \$8 million and the economic impact to the state is more than \$25 million," Chandler tion in all species and sizes, notes says.

and 9 have tree farms. Most of these farms are choose-n-cut operations and owners also sell some trees wholesale, Chandler says.

Across the United States, surveys among Christmas tree growers are resulting in optimism about ample tree supply prospects for the coming holiday season.

Consumers nationally should benefit this year from increased Christmas tree plantings of five and six years ago. Prices are expected to remain near last year's retail level, the survey indicates.

Generally, U. S. consumers should have an excellent tree selec-Fred Strathmeyer of Dover, Pa., president of the National Christmas Tree Association. "This is good news for the real Christmas tree enthusiasts," Strathmeyer says.

Last year, a total of 32.7 million trees were sold, and 1987 sales are expected to be about 33.3 million Christmas trees.

Consumer surveys also show that natural and artificial trees have about an equal share of users. But, real trees led slightly with 38 percent of the market share, compared to 35 percent of the market for artificial trees. About 27 percent of homes use no tree at all.

## Sunnyside By Teeny Bowden, 647-5703

He was born and raised in the community and attended Sunnyside Grade School and Dimmitt High School. Teeny Bowden came home Saturday afternoon from Amarillo after they had taken out the temporary pacemaker which helped L. B.'s heart make it through surgery Tuesday. L. B. had emergency surgery on the fistula in his arm in St. Anthonys the 9th following his regular doctor's check-up. He was sent home about an hour after surgery. Got home about 10:30 a.m. and about 3:30 p.m. he began to have a very fast heart rate, and thought he was having a heart attack. He was taken to Dimmitt by ambulance, and transferred to Amarillo when stabilized. His heart rate continued to be very high until during dialysis Thursday when it came down to near normal. He started vomiting and was very sick Friday and the cause was not determined until Saturday night when he spiked a 102 temperature and his white blood count was elevated to the point to confirm peritonitis. Before noon Sunday the internist said surgery, the surgeon was

called in and the kidney doctor also agreed that it could be many things and that surgery was necessary to determine the cause. The cardialogist said the inner muscle of his heart had been damaged by a light heart attack, and could therefore not withstand the surgery. He asked for two days to let it heal more. Early Tuesday morning it seemed evident they would not be able to wait any longer for surgery and a pacemaker was installed to help his heart make it through the procedure. The problem was found to be a blockage caused by adhesions from his previous surgery, a less serious problem than the peritonitis. When they went to dialize him Wednesday his fistula had collapsed. There was no blood in it so they dialyzed him through a vein above his elbow. So Thursday morning he went back to surgery to correct the fistula problem. He remained on the breathing machine from surgery Tuesday until after the surgery Thursday, and is still wearing an oxygen mask.
