Europe May Get Gold From U.S.A.

PHILLIPS PETROLEUM STAKES PECOS LOCATION
The Phillips Petroleum Company staked the location for No. 1 Hin-yard in Northeast Pecos County, about 24 miles northeast of Fort Stockton.

LION PULLING CASING IN CRANE COUNTY TEST
Approximately four miles south-west of Crane in Crane County, the Lion Oil Company No. 1 G. H. Cowden, 660 feet from north and west lines of section 14, block X, CCSD&RGNG survey, is pulling 5 1/2-inch casing. The Devonian has been abandoned as a dry section and the area around 2,700 feet will be tested for possible production.

MABEE NO. 1 HEYDRICK IS DRILLING AHEAD
In Andrews County, the Mabee Drilling Company No. 1 Heydrick, 1,980 feet from south and 660 feet from west lines of section 6, block A-41, psi survey, is drilling ahead below 10,153 feet in Ellenburger dolomite.

A one-hour drillstem test was taken at 10,050-130 feet. The recovery was 500 feet of drilling mud. This tester is two and one-half miles northwest of the Martin pool, and is contracted to drill to about 11,500 feet with rotary.

CROCKETT COUNTY TEST PREPARES TO RUN CASING
The Humble Oil & Refining Company No. 1-G Owens, 660 feet from south and west lines of section 6, block CG, H&GN survey, has ceased drilling at 5,900 feet in lime. A Schlumberger survey was run to the total depth.

COCHRAN COUNTY WILDCAT IS AT TD OF 4,798 FEET
Ray A. Albright No. 1 Allie D. Slaughter, et al. a wildcat eight miles east of Morton, in Northeast Cochran County, is at a total depth of 4,798 feet. There was soft drilling at 4,790-98 feet with a fair stain and slight porosity. The hole is now being conditioned in order to core.

It is located 440 feet from north and east lines of labor 84, league 82, Shackelford County School Lands. The contract depth is 5,000 feet.

PHILLIPS NO. 1 FORBESS IN ECTOR IS COMPLETED
In Ector County, 660 feet from south and west lines of section 26, block B-15, psi survey, Phillips No. 1 Forbess, completed on a 24-hour potential for 200.54 barrels of 42.5 gravity oil, flowing through 3 1/2-inch choke. The gas-oil ratio was 486-1.

This is the second well completed in the Penwell-Ellenburger field. The production came from the zone above 8,957 feet.

\$12,295,359 Is Bid Total For Leases
AUSTIN—(AP)—The largest mineral lease sale in the history of the state Tuesday brought high bids totaling \$12,295,359 on 600,394 acres of state-owned submerged lands under threat of federal encroachment. The bonus bids are in addition to \$1 per acre per year rental fee, which would bring another \$600,394 per year from the sale if bids are accepted on all the acreage. Individual high bid was for \$345,348, made by Superior Oil Corporation and Pure Oil Company on a 942-acre tract in Laguna Madre. Actual awards to successful bidders will not be made for about two weeks, Bascom Giles, commissioner of the general land office and chairman of the State School Land Board, said. On some tracts, sale of which is under protest, up to eight weeks may be required for decisions. Revenue from the sale goes to the Permanent School Fund.

Leaders Ponder Proposal

WASHINGTON—(AP)—A proposal to ship some of America's huge gold hoard to Europe in connection with the Marshall Recovery Plan is receiving serious consideration from top administration officials.

The essence of the gold proposal as described by officials familiar with it is this: The Administration would ask Congress to authorize a European stabilization fund of about \$3,000,000,000 to be administered by the Treasury. This would be an addition to the \$6,000,000,000 to \$7,000,000,000 in gifts and loans which probably will be recommended to feed Europe and revive lagging production.

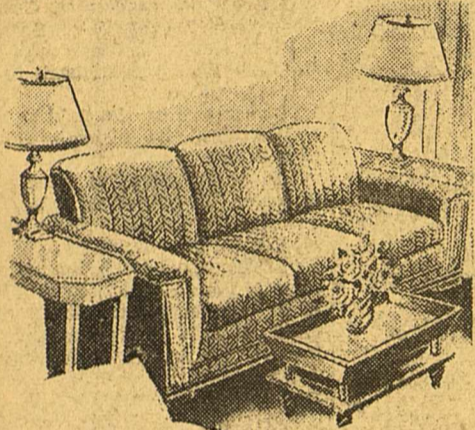

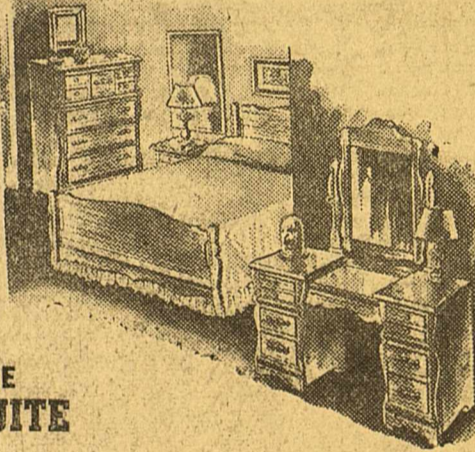

Taylor To Pilot Brownies

ST. LOUIS—(AP)—The St. Louis Browns had a new manager Wednesday—James Wren (Zach) Taylor—to succeed Herold (Muddy) Ruel, whose work was called disappointing by club officials.

Taylor comes to the Browns from the Pittsburgh Pirates, where he was a coach last season. He had served with St. Louis previously. He has spent nearly 20 years in organized baseball.

Club President Richard C. Muckerman, in announcing Ruel's dismissal, said Muddy's contract, which had one more year to run, would be paid in full.

It was the second consecutive time the Browns have hired a manager for two years and fired him after one. Luke Sewell was relieved shortly before the end of the 1946 season, less than half way through his two-year contract.

Muddy Is 'Stunned'

Ruel, 51, resigned as assistant to Baseball Commissioner A. B. (Happy) Chandler to take over the club. He took issue with a statement by Muckerman that, although the club finished last this year, material on hand was sufficient for a first division team. Ruel said he was "stunned" by the action.

Taylor served as acting manager of the Browns for a brief period in 1946—after Sewell was released until end of the season. He was coach with the St. Louis club and before that served as manager of San Antonio in the Texas League and Toledo in the American Association—both Brownie farms.

The new Brownie manager, 49, played with the Dodgers, Yankees, Braves, Giants and Cubs as catcher during his career.
